I myself am a pure Ophiuchus, which means that the entire blueprint of the pure Ophiuchus is hidden within me. Through self-analysis, I can uncover everything about this character. For this self-analysis, I use astrology and numerology.

My book is primarily intended for people who already know something about astrology. Nevertheless, I keep everything as accessible as possible for people who are new to the subject. In addition, I will teach you everything you need to know about numerology.

## Introduction: Through Hell and Back

Before I begin sharing my knowledge and wisdom, I want to make it very clear that I experience a life that many people quite clearly do not. I understand that people have a great deal of difficulty with the claims I make, but everything is based on the way I have been allowed to experience life. I have become familiar with the afterlife, paranormal gifts, and the zodiac sign of the Serpent Bearer. I have also managed to acquire knowledge of numerology. I am familiar with illusion. It is the point where truth and fiction become difficult to distinguish from one another. I have to make do with the knowledge available today. I am certainly not always right. I, too, am misinformed, which means that I unknowingly carry incorrect information with me. In the past, I have sometimes been completely wrong about things because I did not rely on my own experiences, but instead adopted someone else's point of view. In that sense, I have had to cleanse myself of corruption. I no longer simply accept everything people tell me.

I know what it is like to be manic. I work from exhaustion to exhaustion, so it sometimes happens that, when I am racing through the material, I become slightly manic again. I then see connections on a very deep level that do not actually exist. My imagination starts leading a life of its own. I know the material of the Serpent Bearer and numerology extremely well.

I also do not mind making mistakes, as long as I learn from them. I always strive for the highest and best possible result, but I also strive for the ultimate truth. I deliberately wrote my book in such a way that I only refer to things I am 100% certain about. That is also why my book has such an assertive tone. I have pursued this with pure discipline and passion to such an extent that I have even managed to accomplish the impossible. I have worked all forms of doubt out of my system after endlessly criticizing my own work. As I said: prove me wrong.

My book is structured as follows:

I begin by bringing the forgotten zodiac sign, the Serpent Bearer, back to life. Everything in this book revolves around it. I demonstrate with three solid arguments that the Serpent Bearer is still officially part of astrology. It is therefore up to me to introduce this sign once again.

In the past, I often encountered a certain pattern that would return every so often. I would discover that the pattern I kept experiencing referred to the creation story of Germanic mythology. Thanks to this realization, I uncovered the entire identity of God. In this book, I therefore tell you who and what God actually is.

I am a Serpent Bearer myself, and I have had many extraordinary experiences throughout my life. Precisely because there is such a major taboo surrounding psychic gifts and the afterlife, I have decided to share a number of these experiences. These experiences are all part of my training as a pure Serpent Bearer.

When it comes to numerology, I will teach you everything you need to know. I also had to build this subject from the ground up. Everything comes from my own hand. I even have my own formula, called the Formula of Odin. This technique has proven to be correct every single time.

I conclude with a self-analysis, because I carry the blueprint of a pure Serpent Bearer within me. In this, I am the very best example the world has to offer.

## The Power of Uranus

Uranus is in Sagittarius in the seventh house and, with an orb of only 0°28', forms an almost exact conjunction with the Sun. This makes Uranus one of the most powerful planets in my birth chart. Uranus therefore forms a thick red line through my character and expression.

Uranus is the planet of lightning. It represents sudden insights, renewal, independence, and breaking through existing patterns of thought. The power of Uranus can cause an insight to strike like a bolt of lightning: unexpected, powerful, and sometimes with the ability to open up a completely new perspective.

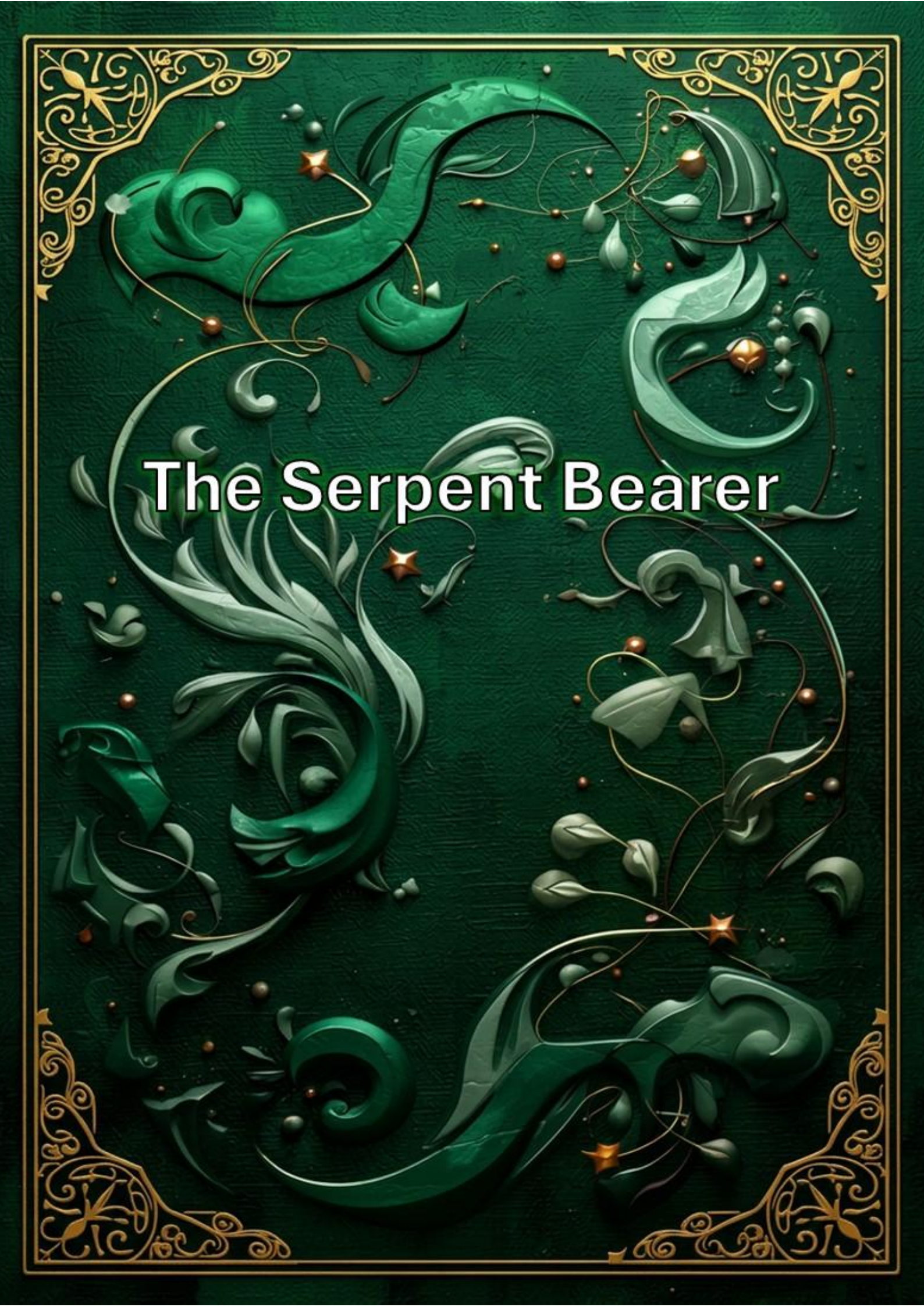
In Sagittarius, this power is primarily directed toward truth, knowledge, philosophy, and discovering the bigger picture. This creates the ability not to simply accept existing ideas as truth, but to investigate them again and view them from a different perspective.

The strong connection with my Sun makes this Uranian power a very important part of my identity. It gives me a strong need to think independently, draw my own conclusions, and follow my own path.

The sextile between Uranus and Mars further strengthens the ability to actually turn insights into action. As a result, a new idea can not only be discovered, but also developed and put into practice.

Uranus therefore primarily represents the power of lightning in my birth chart: the ability to suddenly see new connections, break open existing ideas, and search for what lies hidden behind them.

## The Thirteenth Sign

When it comes to modern astrology, I have noticed that a number of things are already going wrong at the very foundation. I am someone who investigates a subject and then discovers it in my own way and at my own pace. When I became familiar with numerology, I only then began to notice the fundamental errors. Everything indicates that a zodiac sign is missing.

When I started studying astrology, I soon came across the thirteenth sign. It caught my attention and later even became an obsession. What I had absolutely no idea about at the time was that I myself represent the Serpent Bearer in its purest form. Over the past 18 years, I have invested all my energy into uncovering this lost identity. Unconsciously, I have been constantly occupied with this, with emphasis on the word 'unconsciously'.

When I look back at everything, my entire destiny appears to have been built around uncovering my hidden identity. Now that I know my true nature, I am finally standing in my power. All uncertainty has made way for pure self-confidence. I will not shy away from a discussion with anyone, nor will I hide myself.

My claims are extremely accurate because that is the level I constantly demand of myself. My goal is to hit every sensitive nerve. I look at the whole picture. I know certain things with certainty based on a number of unique experiences. For that reason, I can make far-reaching statements that no other human being can make. As a pure Serpent Bearer, I was specifically made for this task. I reveal what is hidden.

## The Hidden Zodiac Sign

The Serpent Bearer is a hidden zodiac sign, and that is precisely why astrologers do not recognize it. To uncover the Serpent Bearer, you have to go one step deeper and look at the relationship between the Sun and the Moon. This means that the horoscope does not change in its outward appearance. The twelve zodiac signs remain exactly as they are; no shifts take place.

We also have two types of Serpent Bearers. There is a normal version and there is a pure version. What makes the Serpent Bearer elusive as a zodiac sign is that its energy falls precisely within the period of Sagittarius. The period of the Serpent Bearer runs from November 29 through December 18. As a Serpent Bearer, you therefore have to have been born specifically during this period.

What makes the Serpent Bearer what it is, is the fact that it is a true mixture of the energies of Sagittarius and Scorpio. These two zodiac signs form each other's counterpart and are defined by pure conflict. It is water on steroids versus fire on steroids. Sagittarius, as an energy, wants only to rise upward, while Scorpio wants only to explore the depths.

In the conflict zone (the transition) between Scorpio and Sagittarius, the energy is so intense that a new life is created in the form of the Serpent Bearer. The Serpent Bearer is therefore always a child born under the energies of the Sun in Sagittarius opposing the Moon in Scorpio.

When we look at the elements in astrology, each zodiac sign essentially possesses two elements. Scorpio is associated with water and air, while Sagittarius is associated with fire and air. You could think of Sagittarius as a hot, dry wind. Scorpio is a cold, moist wind. When both elements come together, lightning occurs in nature.

You may understand now that the Serpent Bearer carries its own unique element. Lightning represents creation, light, life, and cosmic order. Thunder is also represented in astrology, but it can only form when lightning (the Serpent Bearer) is present. If the Ascendant of the Serpent Bearer is Gemini, then this Gemini energy transforms into thunder. With thunder, everything revolves around destruction, darkness, death, and chaos.

### Misconceptions Surrounding the Serpent Bearer

There are an enormous number of people who are unfamiliar with the zodiac sign of the Serpent Bearer. What many astrologers fail to realize is that the Serpent Bearer is a fixed part of the zodiac; after all, it literally has its foot on top of it.

Many people use the name Ophiuchus, a name that most people do not even know how to pronounce correctly, but the original name of this zodiac sign is simply the Serpent Bearer.

I want to immediately clear up a major misconception. Everyone refers to this as the thirteenth sign, but the reality is that the Serpent Bearer occupies the ninth position. The actual thirteenth sign is connected to the zodiac sign Pisces.

This zodiac sign is by no means new, either. Pillar 43 of the ruins of Göbekli Tepe in Turkey demonstrates that the Serpent Bearer was already known to our ancestors more than 12,000 years ago. It was Christianity and the Catholic Church that deliberately erased this zodiac sign from the history books. After all, the Serpent Bearer was still known among our Germanic ancestors, and the ancient Greeks wrote countless myths about it. What almost nobody realizes is that the pure Serpent Bearer is literally woven into our Dutch days of the week.

### Famous Serpent Bearers

The Serpent Bearer consists of three different parts as a zodiac sign. We have the bearer of the Serpent (human), the head of the Serpent, and the tail of the Serpent. The Serpent is so incredibly broad that it lies connected to the zodiac signs Libra, Scorpio, and Sagittarius. This is an important fact when we look at the Egyptian myths.

When it comes to the Serpent Bearer as a zodiac sign, it has become very clear to me that this zodiac sign does not possess a fixed identity. This becomes especially clear in the Greek myths. Here is a list of famous Serpent Bearers:

**Egyptian:** Anubis is the bearer. Ma'at, Ammit, and Thoth form the Serpent.

**Greek:** Apollo and Artemis together, Chiron, and Asclepius are all Serpent Bearers. Hermes forms the thunder. The supreme god Zeus is a pure Serpent Bearer.

**Germanic:** Odin is a Serpent Bearer and Thor forms the thunder. Father and son together form a pure Serpent Bearer.

As you may notice, remnants of this lost zodiac sign can still be found, primarily in ancient cultures.

## Uranus at Work

When astrology and numerology are applied together, it becomes clear that the Serpent Bearer is indeed part of the whole. The reason I say this is that astrology contains serious fundamental errors that, once again, no one seems to have noticed. It therefore proved worthwhile to investigate things myself and discover astrology in my own way, without outside help. I discovered three major conflicts that can be found within the symbolic values.

### Conflict: The Libra in Imbalance

The first problem I encounter is that the whole system of twelve zodiac signs is out of balance. Libra does not do justice to its name and identity at all, because the entire system of twelve zodiac signs is characterized by imbalance and instability. Libra occupies the seventh position and carries two scales. If we look at the first scale, we have the zodiac signs Aries, Taurus, Gemini, Cancer, Leo, and Virgo. That means there are six zodiac signs on the first scale.

The second scale carries the zodiac signs Scorpio, Sagittarius, Capricorn, Aquarius, and Pisces. The second scale carries only five zodiac signs. In short, the scales are not balanced. Libra does not form the center of the whole. This indicates that a zodiac sign is missing from the second scale.

By adding the Serpent Bearer to the ninth position, between Scorpio and Sagittarius, both scales are brought back into balance. Each scale carries six zodiac signs, and Libra once again lives up to its title.

### Conflict: Elements

The next problem that arises has everything to do with the elements. At the foundation of astrology, we have the elements fire, earth, air, and water. However, it is known from many historical texts that the Serpent Bearer possesses its own unique element, namely the element of 'lightning'.

If I take the twelve zodiac signs and apply numerology to them, we run into a conflict. In numerology, the number 10 has the same value as the number 1.

- $10 = 1 + 0 = 1$

The number 11 has the same value as the number 2.

- $11 = 1 + 1 = 2$

With the current twelve zodiac signs, Aries occupies the first position and the tenth zodiac sign is Capricorn. The conflict arises when we look at the elements. Aries versus Capricorn is Fire versus Earth. The elements clearly do not correspond with one another and are therefore in conflict.



If I use the thirteen zodiac signs, Sagittarius occupies the tenth position with the element of fire. All the elements are then once again in harmony from a numerological perspective. All of them, without ever coming into conflict again. In short, by adding the Serpent Bearer, everything is brought back into balance, which indicates and demonstrates that the Serpent Bearer was indeed once part of the whole.

### Conflict: Zodiac Sign Type

The third conflict can be found in the zodiac sign type. If we assume there are only twelve zodiac signs, then the zodiac sign types no longer correspond. This last point is important because the identity of God has been incorporated into the knowledge of astrology.

There is a certain frequency, and we call it the 1-4-7, the 2-5-8, and the 3-6-9. There is a constant division into three, and when I follow this concept, something stands out to me when I add the Serpent Bearer to the sequence.

The 1-4-7 is a neutral element. It includes the zodiac signs Aries, Cancer, Libra, Sagittarius, and Pisces.

The 2-5-8 is a negative element. It includes the zodiac signs Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, and Capricorn.

The 3-6-9 is a positive element. It includes the zodiac signs Gemini, Virgo, Serpent Bearer, and Aquarius.

For those who were paying close attention:

The 1-4-7 is neutral because it includes multiple zodiac sign types. It is very accepting toward others. The zodiac sign types belonging to this group are animals, a hybrid, and an object.

When we look at the 2-5-8, it becomes noticeable that only animals belong to it. It therefore revolves around animal instinct.

When we look at the 3-6-9, all the zodiac signs are of the human type. The 3-6-9 revolves around humanity. Thanks to the Serpent Bearer, I have managed to completely restore the foundation of astrology.

## History: The Serpent Bearer

Now that I have demonstrated that the Serpent Bearer is still part of the whole, it is time to search for the remnants. Because very little is still known about Germanic mythology, the Serpent Bearer can be found in other cultures, such as among the ancient Egyptians and Greeks. I will cover all three cultures in their pure simplicity. I will only share the information I consider necessary.

Let us begin with the oldest source. In this case, we are dealing with the ruins of Göbekli Tepe, which date back more than 12,000 years. If we look at Pillar 43, we see a vulture spreading its wings at a very specific angle. That vulture is the Serpent Bearer, because Scorpio stands at its foot and that strange angle of the wings has the same angle as the Serpent. If we look at the constellation of Scorpio, its identity has remained unchanged for the past 12,000 years. Recognition of the existence of the Serpent Bearer therefore goes back more than 12,000 years and is anything but a new or fashionable subject.

## Egypt: Ma'at and Anubis (3000 B.C.)

The oldest hints concerning the identity of the Serpent Bearer can be found in ancient Egypt. While among the Greeks he was primarily seen as the healer, in Egypt the Serpent Bearer was associated with the final judgment in the afterlife. The Serpent Bearer forms the cycle of the so-called Ma'at.

## The Final Judgment in the Afterlife

In ancient Egypt, Ma'at is the goddess of universal order, truth, justice, and balance. She represents the principle upon which the entire universe is built. Her primary function is to safeguard cosmic balance and ensure that chaos does not take over the universe. She plays a role in the realm of the dead. During the Weighing of the Heart, the heart of the deceased is placed on the scales. On the other side of the scales lies the feather of Ma'at. If the heart is as light as her feather, the person has lived according to the principles of truth and justice and may proceed into the afterlife.

Thoth is the god of writing, science, magic, the Moon, and wisdom. He is known as the inventor of hieroglyphs and acts as the divine scribe. His primary function is to record and manage all knowledge, laws, and divine decisions. His task is to record the judgment of the Weighing of the Heart impartially and accurately. He checks whether the scales are balanced and records the final verdict in the divine annals.

Ammit was not a goddess who was worshipped, but a demonic being that the Egyptians greatly feared. Her primary function is to carry out the verdict and completely destroy the impure soul. Ammit sits beneath the scales waiting. When the heart proves to be heavier than the feather of Ma'at, meaning that the person has lived a bad or dishonest life, Ammit immediately devours the heart. This brings about the 'second death': the soul ceases to exist and can never attain eternal life.

### Psychopomp Anubis

Anubis played one of the most crucial and active roles in the Egyptian realm of the dead. Where Ma'at provided the standard, Thoth recorded the judgment, and Ammit stood ready to punish, Anubis was the guide, protector, and executor of the transition into the afterlife. Anubis serves the god Osiris, the one who rules over the afterlife.

Anubis served as the guide of the deceased. As soon as someone died, Anubis took the soul on the dangerous journey through the underworld. He ensured that the soul safely reached the hall of judgment and did not fall prey to demons or evil forces along the way.

### My Interpretation: The Serpent

What immediately draws my attention is the role of Anubis. When it comes to the sign of the Serpent Bearer, it was known in ancient times that it had the role of a psychopomp. A psychopomp is a guide who accompanies the dead through the afterlife and brings the soul to its final destination. It is precisely this characteristic that reveals that Anubis represents a Serpent Bearer.

As I indicated earlier, the Serpent Bearer consists of three parts. We have the bearer, the head, and the tail. Anubis is the bearer of the Serpent. The Serpent he holds is connected to the zodiac signs Libra (Ma'at), Scorpio (Ammit), and Sagittarius (Thoth).

### The Instruments of Anubis

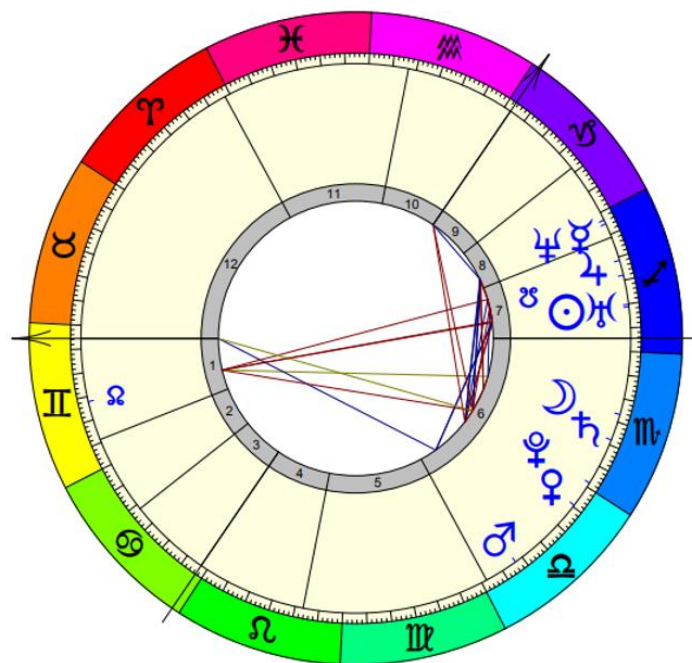
The identity of Libra is quite clearly represented by the Egyptian goddess Ma'at. Ma'at stands for truth, justice, order, and balance. She represents the principle that everything must be in equilibrium. This strongly corresponds with Libra, which in astrology is likewise associated with balance, justice, and weighing what is right and fair. It is about seeking equilibrium and fairly weighing both sides.

If we then look at the demon Ammit, it becomes clear that she fits Scorpio well. Ammit is the being that strikes when a person's heart has become too heavy through sins, lies, or a lack of balance. She represents total destruction: the 'second death', in which everything impure is irreversibly destroyed.

In astrology, Scorpio has a similar meaning. The planet Pluto, which belongs to Scorpio, also represents destruction, transformation, and letting go of what no longer suits you. Scorpio forces you to look honestly at yourself and confront everything you would rather

keep hidden. It is about confronting your own darker sides. Just as there was no negotiation with Ammit when the scales tipped, Scorpio leaves little room for self-deception or appearances. What is not right must be addressed, released, or destroyed. Only then can there be room for something new.

Finally, there is Thoth, who corresponds well with the archetype of Sagittarius. Sagittarius represents justice, philosophy, and the search for truth. Thoth represents wisdom, knowledge, and the laws that, according to Egyptian mythology, keep the world in balance. Thoth is regarded as a divine lawgiver who watches over justice, order, and ethics. Where Sagittarius searches for a higher form of truth and justice, Thoth records this truth. He records and safeguards what has occurred according to the divine order.

### Osiris: Ruler of the Afterlife

Osiris was one of the most important gods of ancient Egypt and was primarily worshipped as the ruler of the afterlife. He was associated with death, rebirth, fertility, and eternal life. His position as god of the dead was closely connected to his own death and the events that followed.

Osiris was originally the king of Egypt. He brought order and civilization to the people and was known as a just ruler. However, his brother Seth turned against him out of



jealousy. He murdered Osiris and made his body disappear. Isis, the wife of Osiris, then went in search of her husband and managed to find his body. With the help of her divine powers, Osiris was brought back to life. His return, however, did not mean that he became king of the world of the living again. Instead, he was given kingship over the afterlife.

This gave Osiris an exceptional position within Egyptian religion. He himself had died, but he had overcome death by obtaining a new form of existence. His story therefore became a powerful symbol of the idea that death did not have to mean the definitive end of existence. Osiris represented the transition from earthly life to an eternal existence.

As ruler of the afterlife, Osiris received and judged the deceased. During the judgment, the heart of a deceased person was weighed against the feather of Ma'at, the symbol of truth, justice, and cosmic order. Those who had lived righteously could be admitted into eternal life. As a result, Osiris became not only the ruler of the dead, but also a god closely associated with judgment, justice, and rebirth.

The story of Osiris made him one of the central figures in the Egyptian conception of life and death. He was the king who died, continued his existence in another form, and ultimately became the king of a world beyond earthly existence.

## Greek Mythology

When it comes to the Greek myths, I would like to share every story with you. However, the chapter would become very disorganized as a result. In addition, I have come to the conclusion that there is only one story that truly matters, and that is the story of Asclepius.

What I have therefore been able to discover is that all the figures in the story play a role in forming a Serpent Bearer. They all have a connection with this sign. I will therefore share the entire story of Asclepius and then explain how each figure plays a role in the story.

There are also many different Greek myths and different storylines. I therefore share the myths as I have learned them.

## The Story of Asclepius

The story of Asclepius is about a man who, according to Greek mythology, grew into an exceptional healer. He eventually became so skilled at healing people that he was even able to cross the boundary between life and death. It was precisely this that ultimately led to his downfall.

Asclepius was the son of Apollo, an important Greek god who was associated, among other things, with the Sun, truth, prophecy, and healing. His mother was Coronis, a mortal princess from Thessaly.

When Coronis was pregnant with Asclepius, she fell in love with another man, Ischys. Apollo wanted to punish Coronis for her infidelity and asked his twin sister Artemis to kill her. Artemis was a goddess known, among other things, as a huntress and protector of nature. She killed Coronis with her arrows.

When Coronis's body lay upon the funeral pyre and the flames had already begun to burn, Apollo changed his mind. He did not want his unborn child to die. He removed Asclepius from his mother's womb and thereby saved his son's life.

Asclepius was then raised by Chiron. According to Greek mythology, Chiron was a centaur: a creature with the upper body of a human and the body of a horse. Unlike the wild centaurs in many other stories, Chiron was wise, calm, and highly knowledgeable. He had knowledge of subjects including astronomy, music, and medicine.

Chiron taught Asclepius everything he knew about medicine. As a result, Asclepius became an exceptionally skilled healer. He learned to work with herbs and treatments and became increasingly skilled at healing illnesses and injuries.

Asclepius eventually became so skilled at his craft that, according to the stories, he could not only heal the sick, but even bring the dead back to life. In doing so, he received help from Athena, an important Greek goddess associated, among other things, with strategic wisdom. She gave Asclepius two bottles containing the blood of Medusa. Medusa was a creature from Greek mythology with snakes for hair. Her gaze was said to be capable of turning people to stone.

According to the story, the blood from one side of Medusa's body had a deadly effect, while the blood from the other side had the power to bring the dead back to life. Asclepius used this extraordinary power to bring people back from death. In doing so, however, Asclepius crossed a boundary that, according to Greek mythology, was not meant to be crossed: the boundary between life and death.

The god Hades, the ruler of the underworld, noticed that fewer and fewer dead people were entering his realm. He therefore saw the actions of Asclepius as a threat. Hades went to his brother Zeus, the most powerful of the Greek gods, and warned him.

According to Hades, the world would become unbalanced if people could overcome death without limits. If no one ever had to die anymore, the difference between humans and gods would become increasingly smaller. The boundary between life and death would thereby disappear.

Zeus understood the danger of this. He decided that Asclepius had to be punished and killed him with a bolt of lightning.

Eventually, Zeus realized that Asclepius had not acted out of bad intentions. He had wanted to help people and had done much good with his knowledge. Nevertheless, according to Zeus, he had crossed a boundary that was not meant to be broken by a human being. To honor Asclepius, Zeus therefore gave him a place in the heavens. He made him the constellation Serpent Bearer, also known as Ophiuchus. In this way, Asclepius was not only associated with healing and overcoming death, but also received a permanent place among the stars as the Serpent Bearer.

### My Interpretation: Asclepius

What makes the story of Asclepius so remarkable are the details woven into the story. I have spent years researching the Serpent Bearer, and all the Greek Serpent Bearers I have been able to discover appear in the story of Asclepius.

### Apollo and Artemis

To begin with, the twins Apollo and Artemis together represent the sign of the Serpent Bearer. In other myths, such as the story of Orion, it becomes apparent that Artemis represents Scorpio. Because Artemis is associated with the Moon, we can say that Artemis represents the Moon in Scorpio.

The same applies to Apollo. There are myths indicating that he represents the Sun, but there is also a myth that directly equates him with the archetype of a Sagittarius. In the story concerning the Temple of Delphi, Apollo fights the gigantic Python with his bow and arrow. This makes Apollo a Sagittarius.

In short:

- Artemis represents the Moon in Scorpio.
- Apollo represents the Sun in Sagittarius.
- Together, they form the Serpent Bearer.

### The Wounded Healer Chiron

When it comes to Chiron, there are different versions of the same story. The version people rarely get to see is the version that describes how Chiron was given the constellation of the Serpent Bearer as an honor.

The key lies in the following:

Through an unfortunate movement by Hercules, the arrow fell and pierced deep into Chiron's foot. The arrow had been soaked in the poisonous blood of the Hydra, a deadly and incurable poison that caused unbearable pain. Because Chiron was immortal, he could not die and was forced to carry this unbearable pain with him. Death offered him no relief.

If we look at the night sky and the position of the constellation of Hercules, it is located directly above the constellation of the Serpent Bearer.

If you draw a straight line downward or let an arrow fall toward the zodiac, you end up at the foot of the Serpent Bearer, the small section that connects the constellation to the zodiac.

At the foot of the Serpent Bearer stands Scorpio with its incurable and deadly poison. The Hydra in this story is Scorpio, which symbolically pierces the Serpent Bearer in his foot.

According to the alternative Greek myth, Chiron therefore also had the constellation of the Serpent Bearer named after him, as an honor for giving up his immortality.

### Virgo: Athena

Athena is one of the most important goddesses in Greek mythology. She is primarily the goddess of wisdom, intellect, strategy, and craftsmanship. She is known for her ability to analyze situations carefully and then choose a wise solution.

This makes her strongly connected to the character of Virgo. Virgo represents analysis, knowledge, precision, practical intelligence, and improving situations. Athena uses her intellect not only to gather knowledge, but especially to apply that knowledge in practice.

What will emerge later in my book is that the constellation of Virgo is part of the character of the god Odin. In my view, it is remarkable that Hermes, as a psychopomp, does not appear in the story of Asclepius, while Athena does.

### The God of the Underworld: Hades

Another remarkable aspect is the role Hades plays in the story. The myth states that Asclepius was able to circumvent death by bringing people back to life. In the Greek myth, this theme is translated very literally, while the spiritual meaning behind death and resurrection represents bringing back into motion that which has come to a standstill.

The fact that Hades appears in the story as ruler of the underworld is remarkable, because the Serpent Bearer is directly connected to the afterlife. See the reference to Anubis as a psychopomp and the god he serves, Osiris. In Germanic mythology, it is the god Odin who rules over the afterlife and is also a psychopomp. Odin represents Anubis

and Osiris as a unity. As you can see, the Serpent Bearer has a strong connection with the afterlife.

### The Pure Serpent Bearer: Zeus

Zeus is one of the most important gods in Greek mythology and is regarded as the ruler of the gods. He is primarily known as the god of the sky, thunder, and lightning. His thunderbolt is his most important weapon and symbolizes his power and authority. From the heavens, Zeus watches over order and punishes those who violate his laws and rules.

In Greek traditions, it is Zeus who delivers judgment with his lightning. Asclepius met his death when he was struck by lightning. What many people today do not know is that in earlier folklore, this was considered the greatest honor one could receive. Spiritually speaking, Zeus therefore gave him the greatest honor by killing him with a bolt of lightning. The death that followed was not a punishment; instead, it made Asclepius immortal. Today, Asclepius is known as the symbol of our medicine.

Remarkable Characteristic: Born in Conflict

When we look at the Greek Serpent Bearers, they all have one thing in common: they were born during a conflict.

When it comes to Apollo, his mother Leto was fleeing from Hera's vengeful wrath. Hera held the goddess of childbirth captive, causing Leto to endure nine days and nine nights of agonizing labor without being able to give birth. As the story of Apollo indicates, the birth of the Serpent Bearer is accompanied by pain.

Asclepius was born upon the funeral pyre, and Chiron was immediately rejected by his mother at birth. Both Serpent Bearers would be raised by Apollo and Artemis.

### Germanic Mythology: Odin

When I look at Germanic mythology, or rather, at the remnants that have survived, I also encounter the Serpent Bearer there. Many existing sources were destroyed at the command of the Church, and as a result, very little remains known about the traditions of our Germanic ancestors. What many people do not know is that the personality of the pure Serpent Bearer has been incorporated into our days of the week. He has therefore not been completely erased.

When I look at Odin's character, the first thing that stands out to me is that he represents the role of the psychopomp. When it comes to Greek mythology, this characteristic is entrusted to Hermes, who represents the role of the thunder. However, when I look at Egyptian traditions, this archetype of the psychopomp is once again linked to the Serpent Bearer. The ancient texts clearly do not agree on who fulfills this role. I cannot



provide a conclusive answer myself either, because as a pure Serpent Bearer, I control both thunder and lightning. I therefore cannot distinguish who does what.

The next thing I noticed is that Odin rules over the entire afterlife, and that this is the same role represented by Hades. It is known that Odin created multiple layers within the afterlife. Before Odin came to rule over the afterlife, everything revolved around illusion. Odin created a sanctuary for souls, and this heavenly paradise bears the name Asgard. It is therefore Odin who rules as a god over the heavenly paradise, yet in the afterlife he presents himself as an unkempt wanderer. Odin cares very little about status. Just like me, Odin is very aware of the fact that most souls judge others based on their appearance. It is all part of a test.

Never judge a book by its cover.

### God of Occult Knowledge and Wisdom

The story goes that Odin sacrificed his eye to the source of ultimate wisdom. Odin therefore revolves around occult knowledge and wisdom. He sends his ravens out to gather this occult information. Odin also revolves around transformation and self-sacrifice.

The connection with the afterlife is hidden within Odin's ravens. His ravens Huginn and Muninn mean memory and thought. When death occurs, the experience of the soul simply continues, and these two qualities remain. This clearly indicates that the memory of life is not stored in the body; memories and thoughts are connected to the soul.

In addition to two ravens, Odin also had two wolves named Geri and Freki. Their names mean insatiability and greed for food. If we look purely at Odin's totem animals, they indicate that Odin has an insatiable hunger for occult knowledge and wisdom. It is an extremely restless energy that always remains in motion.

Odin revolves around transformation. He is known as a so-called shapeshifter. He can transform into animals and often appears as an owl. It is the animal that hunts silently in the darkness.

Odin was never popular until the moment he sacrificed his eye to the source of wisdom. It was at that point that Odin gained his status as a master of knowledge and wisdom. He made a sacrifice, and that earned him divine status.

There is also another aspect of self-sacrifice and transformation to be found. Odin hung upside down from the tree Yggdrasil for nine days, pierced by his own spear, in order to obtain the knowledge of the runes.

## The Dutch Days of the Week

As I indicated earlier, the Church made an enormous effort to erase the existence of Odin's legend. In Latin, this is called *damnatio memoriae*. It means erasing someone's memory. Yet our Dutch ancestors stood their ground. The Church wanted us to give Wednesday a different name, the day dedicated to Odin. Odin is the central figure of Germanic and Norse mythology. You can understand that he stood greatly in the way of the fictional cult hero known as Jesus. I want to conclude this chapter with an overview of the meaning of the days of the week. Our days of the week revolve around cosmic order. They tell a story about being a pure Serpent Bearer, in all its facets.

### Sunday and Monday

The week begins with Sunday and Monday. This is an ancient reference to astrology, because people in the past primarily studied the Sun and the Moon as celestial bodies. We therefore have the day of the Sun first, followed by the day of the Moon. The Sun represents the masculine, while the Moon represents the feminine.

### Tuesday: The Day of Týr

Tuesday has its own myth. The god Týr represented the principles of honesty, agreements, and cosmic order. He stood for the idea that rules and oaths had to be respected, even if doing so meant personal loss.

The best-known story about Týr is his encounter with the wolf Fenrir. When the gods wanted to bind Fenrir because he posed a danger to the world, Fenrir did not trust them. He demanded that one god place his hand inside his mouth as proof that they were playing fair. Only Týr had the courage to do this. When it became clear that the binding Gleipnir could not be broken, Fenrir bit off Týr's hand. As a result, Týr became a symbol of courage and sacrificing oneself for a greater purpose.

Týr was originally the most important war god. His form of warfare, however, was not the savage destruction associated with Thor, but the more principled side of conflict: honor, courage, and justice.

### Wednesday: The Day of Odin

Odin is one of the most important gods in Germanic mythology. He is often regarded as the god of wisdom, knowledge, magic, and the search for hidden truth. He is known as someone who is willing to make great sacrifices in order to obtain more knowledge.

Odin revolves around struggle, yet the concept of struggle does not necessarily have to involve physical warfare. You can also struggle for a conviction, for a goal, against an illness, or against other difficulties in life.

Odin is not a warrior who fights with weapons, but rather a spiritual warrior. He is someone who enters the struggle by seeking knowledge, pushing boundaries, and

exposing hidden truths. His struggle therefore primarily takes place in the realm of knowledge and awareness. He dares to engage with subjects that others would rather avoid. In this sense, Odin represents breaking taboos, seeking knowledge about the unknown, and sharing insights with others.

Thursday: The Day of Thor

Odin fathered a child with Mother Earth, and his name was Thor. Thor is the protector of humanity. Thor is the child of heaven and earth. He protects the cosmic laws against chaos.

As a child, Thor was extremely difficult to raise. This indicates that the power of thunder is not easy to handle. In order to control these intense forces, Thor was raised by two thunder gods.

This is remarkable, because Apollo, as a Serpent Bearer, took on the upbringing of Chiron and Asclepius. In that story as well, it is a thunder god who adopts and trains other thunder gods.

### Friday: The Day of Frigg

Frigg is the wife of Odin and the queen of the Aesir. Where Odin is often portrayed as the traveler, investigator, and seeker of hidden knowledge, Frigg represents more of the fixed order within the home and the cosmos.

It is interesting that Frigg is often associated with what is hidden and invisible. Odin actively seeks knowledge through travel, sacrifices, and magic, while Frigg seems to possess this knowledge through intuition and insight. She knows much, but speaks little.

If Odin represents the power of seeking truth, then Frigg represents the power of inner knowing. She is the guardian of the connections between people: marriage, family, loyalty, and social order.

### Saturday: The Day of Saturn

Saturday does not belong in the sequence. This is the day that was added later through Roman influences. It carries false value. What I have discovered is that our original weekly calendar officially consisted of six days rather than seven. This is important because the number 7 does not connect time harmoniously. It is irregular and inconsistent. Look at the different lengths of the months; in my view, it is all illogical chaos.

Saturn, on the other hand, represents order, structure, and time. If I want to restore the calendar, I therefore have to return to a division of time that is logical, fixed, and harmoniously structured.

When we look at the earliest written history of humanity, the number 6 immediately appears as the absolute foundation of time measurement. Approximately 5,000 years ago, the Sumerians in ancient Mesopotamia developed what is known as the sexagesimal system: a mathematical system based on the number 60.

For thousands of years, our ancestors worked to make the yearly calendar function correctly. The problem is that the days gradually drift out of alignment, meaning that corrections continually have to be made to the calendar. For example, in 1582, when the Gregorian calendar was introduced, the calendar was corrected by skipping a number of days.

I am therefore going to do something completely different now. I am finally going to make the yearly calendar function correctly, without any complicated procedures. I am going to do this in the pure style of Saturn, who rules over order and time. I am going to restore the division of time by returning to the source code of the Sumerians, where everything revolves around the number 6.

Today we have a great deal of technology and knowledge at our disposal, which makes the calculations easier for me. It is known, for example, that a year consists of approximately 365.25 days. We therefore fall one day behind every four years. I have managed to solve our yearly calendar harmoniously, without a leap day, thanks to the concept of six days in the week.

Look at the following division of time:

- We have 60 seconds in a minute. ( $6 + 0 = 6$ )
- We have 60 minutes in an hour. ( $6 + 0 = 6$ )
- A day consists of 24 hours. ( $2 + 4 = 6$ )
- There are 6 days in a week. (6)
- There are 366 days in a year. ( $3 + 6 + 6 = 15 = 1 + 5 = 6$ )
- If we take 7 years of 366 days, we have a total of 2,562 days. ( $2 + 5 + 6 + 2 = 15 = 1 + 5 = 6$ )
- Every eighth year contains 360 days. ( $3 + 6 + 0 = 9$ )
- Every eighth year consists of 60 weeks. ( $6 + 0 = 6$ )

As you can see, I have managed to preserve the number 6. The number 9 indicates that the cycle is complete. Instead of a leap day, we have one fewer week in the year every eighth year.

When it comes to the 366 days per year, each month consists of 30.5 days. This means that a month sometimes begins in the afternoon and at other times during midnight. The months of the eighth year each consist of 30 days. By applying it this way, the months do not have to shift and the yearly calendar remains consistent at all times.

Yet the calendar is still not efficient enough. Every 128 years, we fall one day out of alignment and the calendar has to be adjusted. I propose allowing it to drift by a total of 6 days. In that case, we adjust the time once every 768 years. The 767th and 768th years of each cycle would both contain a period of 360 days.

The great cycle:  $768 \text{ years} \div 8\text{-year cycle} = 96 \text{ cycles}$  ( $9 + 6 = 15 = 1 + 5 = 6$ )

Where the Egyptians and Romans searched for thousands of years for what they sought, namely the creation of a properly functioning yearly calendar, I have succeeded in only a few attempts thanks to having accurate data, my knowledge of numerology, and the fact that I have not relied on the visions of others. I dare to think outside the existing frameworks. Everything comes from my own work.

I have kept the code intact by making everything revolve around the number 6, just as the Sumerians once intended. I owe all of this to my Dutch ancestors and the discovery of the six-day week.

### My Vision: Days of the Week

With the days of the week, I wanted to demonstrate that the Serpent Bearer, including the thunder, still appears in our days of the week. Thanks to the struggle our ancestors fought to protect Odin's identity from the terror of the Church, I have managed to discover my own identity. In Germany, they gave in and replaced Odin's day. I am therefore slightly proud of my Dutch ancestors.

When I look at the story of Thor, he may be a child of Odin, but he represents a completely different aspect. With Odin, everything revolves around acquiring occult knowledge, while with Thor, everything revolves around destructive warfare. They are nothing alike, and that is correct, because as the name of the day indicates, Thor represents the aspect of thunder and therefore not lightning.

Thunder and lightning are opposites, but they work remarkably well together as a team. When we place father and son together, a new character emerges who in astrology is called the pure Serpent Bearer. The only source in which I have managed to find a pure Serpent Bearer is in the Greek myths, and his name is Zeus.

This is my theory: I suspect that Týr represents the supreme god.

The name Týr is derived from the word 'god'. Zeus and Jupiter have the same linguistic origin. However, this is not just any god, but the god of the highest rank. We are dealing with a supreme god here.

Zeus is the supreme god in Greek mythology, and Jupiter is by far the largest planet in our solar system. To give you an example: if you combine all the other planets in our solar system into one whole, Jupiter would still weigh 2.5 times as much. Jupiter is therefore, within this symbolic comparison, the supreme god of all the planets. If I follow



the same line of reasoning, it means that Týr was also regarded as the supreme god of all Germanic peoples.

If we combine Odin, Thor, and Frigg into one unity, I suspect that together they form Týr. If my theory is correct, this means that Týr represents the pure Serpent Bearer, the one who rules over heaven and earth, over thunder and lightning.

I also see a certain hierarchy in the days of the week that supports this theory. In first place comes the Sun. The Sun is the star that makes life on Earth possible. The opposite of the Sun is the Moon. The Moon also has an enormous influence on our human existence, but according to Western standards, it is subordinate to the Sun.

The next highest rank is that of Týr. Tuesday therefore ranks higher in the hierarchy than Wednesday. What the hierarchy indicates is that the only thing that can surpass the character of a Serpent Bearer is a pure Serpent Bearer.

What is so remarkable about the Serpent Bearer is that two pure extremes come together and temper one another. Týr, as the god of justice, inherits the element of destruction and warfare from Thor, but combines this with the knowledge and wisdom of Odin. Added to this are Frigg's intuition and strategic insight.

My interpretation:

- Tuesday: Týr: thunder and lightning (supreme god)
- Wednesday: Odin: lightning (god)
- Thursday: Thor: thunder (god)
- Friday: Frigg: intuition and strategic insight (goddess)

### Summary: The Serpent Bearer

I began this chapter by explaining the birth period of the Serpent Bearer and, in doing so, corrected a number of major misconceptions. I then demonstrated with three clear examples that the Serpent Bearer is not a newly invented constellation, but an original part of the whole. By adding the Serpent Bearer back into the astrological model, the entire system is brought back into harmony.

The fact that the Serpent Bearer is not new is already evident from a ruin approximately 12,000 years old. There, the Serpent Bearer was recognized in the form of a vulture. Among the Egyptians, the Serpent Bearer reappears in the form of Anubis, the psychopomp who guides the deceased into the afterlife and is connected with the instruments of Ma'at. Among the Greeks, the Serpent Bearer takes on multiple identities. In the story of Asclepius, the various characteristics of this sign come together in one extraordinary story. In Germanic mythology, the role of the Serpent Bearer is assigned to Odin.

I then turned my attention to the days of the week. There, I demonstrated that the identity of the Serpent Bearer is still visible today. Odin represents lightning and occult knowledge, Thor represents thunder and destructive power, and Frigg represents intuition and strategic insight. These qualities come together in Týr, who represents the pure Serpent Bearer. Odin, Thor, and Frigg therefore form the building blocks of Týr, and together they form a sacred trinity.

When it came to Saturday, the day of Saturn, I approached the subject in a completely different way. Saturn revolves around karma, order, and time. Based on these characteristics, I began to reconsider the structure of our calendar. I developed a new division of time in which the number 6 is central and in which the calendar is structured harmoniously. Here too, the power of Saturn becomes apparent: creating order in something that was previously unnecessarily complicated and irregular.

When I bring together everything I have covered in this chapter, a clear picture emerges. The Serpent Bearer has never truly disappeared throughout history. Its characteristics can be found in ancient civilizations, mythological stories, gods, constellations, and even in our days of the week. Again and again, the same building blocks return: life and death, knowledge and wisdom, thunder and lightning, transformation, intuition, justice, and exposing hidden truth.

In this chapter, I have brought the Serpent Bearer back to life and revealed its place within the greater whole. With that, I have covered everything relevant to understanding this sign.

In the next chapter, I will take it one step further. I will then focus on the identity of God. A mystery that can only truly be solved once the Serpent Bearer is once again seen as part of the whole.

## Germanic Mythology: The Resurrection of God

I see this as a good moment to share the true identity of God with you, now that we have already discussed Germanic mythology and the Serpent Bearer. What I must immediately point out is that there have been many different writers who have written a story about Odin. When it comes to our days of the week, a different sacred trinity is used, namely Odin, Thor, and Frigg, whereas the creation story revolves around the sacred trinity of the brothers Vili, Vé, and Odin. The sacred trinity in this creation story is therefore completely different.

When it comes to my fate, I have encountered what people would call God on multiple occasions. During each experience, I looked death directly in the eyes and survived every test. What distinguishes God from paranormal abilities or a mental illness is the fact that your entire environment is manipulated. Everyone is a puppet in such a situation, and the people themselves are completely unaware of it. It all happens very subtly.

What was so incredibly remarkable was the fact that a certain pattern kept emerging. A message was being conveyed, but for years I kept running into a wall. I had completely understood the pattern, but I could not find it anywhere. This changed two years ago when I came across another version of the Germanic creation story. All the patterns appeared in that specific small passage of text, so it immediately captured my full attention. Looking back, it is clear that the pattern I experienced was a reference to the true identity behind God.

### The Three Dimensions

When I look at the creation story and read between the lines, I see that the story is told through the relationship between the Æsir and the Vanir. What was so remarkable about the pattern was that two of the three steps carry the same identity, while the other one differs. This is the best metaphor I can give you. Imagine, for example, three cars simultaneously crossing in front of you. All three are identical in terms of make and model. A blue car and a red car come from the left, while a single blue car comes from the right. We therefore have three equal individuals who together form two sides.

The gods who shaped our universe are equal to one another. Two of them belong to the Æsir, namely Vili and Odin, while the Vanir are led by Vé. What I have discovered is that Vili and Odin belong to the Æsir because of their connection with the element of lightning. This element is formed when the elements of fire, air, and water come together. Vili is an air god (Libra) who purely rules over the elements of fire and water. This also makes Vili a god of lightning, or in other words, an Æsir.

When it comes to Vé, his name already reveals what he represents. A waan is another word for illusion. Vé therefore rules as the god of illusion.

I have spent a long time thinking about the creation story, and I believe I have cracked the code. If I am to believe the myth, then there are three brothers (gods) who shaped the universe. Here is the key: each god represents his own dimension.

I am not talking about Einstein and his four dimensions, such as height, width, length, and time. I am talking about a layer of reality that has its own rules and laws. The material life we experience while awake, for example, is a completely different reality/dimension from the dream world. When we are awake, we are bound by fixed rules. When we dream, we live in a reality where anything is possible and nothing makes sense. When we die, we enter the afterlife on Earth, which is yet another completely different layer of reality. In short, we live in three dimensions that overlap, in the same place and at the same moment in time. Each dimension offers the soul a different experience and perception.

The story tells us that Vé entered the universe first. Everything was centered around chaos and illusion. The dimension dominated by Vé is what we know as the dream world. What is remarkable about dreams is that anything can happen. This illusory dimension contains no fixed rules or laws. It is complete chaos.

The brothers Vili and Odin saw that their younger brother was causing problems. The souls that became part of his dimension had no way of escaping. They remained trapped in the illusion without ever waking up. For many, it was an endless nightmare.

The first step was taken by Vili. When Vili entered Vé's universe, it was Vili who devised fixed laws and rules to control the chaos. He brought structure into it. The dimension that subsequently emerged is the living, material world that we know. Vili makes exact sciences such as mathematics, physics, and chemistry possible.

Odin came afterward. While Vili made the world of matter possible by controlling the illusion, Odin took responsibility for the illusion in the afterlife. It was Odin who created multiple layers within the afterlife. Among other things, he is known for his heavenly paradise called Asgard, which serves as a refuge for the soul.

What stands out very strongly is that bad people remain behind on Earth with their souls. They remain trapped in the illusion of life. Souls that have lived a good life are received and sent to another layer. What I want to emphasize is that a final judgment of the soul actually takes place in the afterlife. In the heavenly paradise, the soul returns completely to itself and has an overview of all the lives it has ever lived.

As human beings, we are therefore constantly connected to all three dimensions at the same moment in space and time. Let me put it this way: when I go to sleep, I immediately connect with the dream world. This means that this dimension is always present or switched on in the background. The same applies to the afterlife on Earth. Souls walk among us that we cannot perceive, but they can see and hear us. When we die, we immediately become part of that layer. The afterlife, too, is always switched on in



the background. Put very simply: we are always directly connected to these three dimensions, or to God.

A dimension may appear to have little personality when described in writing, but based on my experiences, I can confirm that each dimension possesses a unique character. Every dimension has an intelligent consciousness. It can intervene in the destiny of human beings. God is the only force in the universe capable of changing a person's fate. I therefore see a dimension as a living being that makes conscious and intelligent choices.

## The Character of God

According to the ancient scriptures, God forms our universe. I myself do not know how far this power extends. It has become clear that it applies to our solar system at a minimum, but it may also extend to our Milky Way galaxy or even much farther than that. The question that must be asked is: How far do the laws of nature and the rules we know on Earth extend? What I do know with 100% certainty is that God derives his character from all thirteen constellations. Every dimension, and therefore every god, has its own character.

When I approach the character of God through the constellations, God represents all thirteen constellations. As human beings, we also carry a sacred trinity within us, and that trinity takes the form of constellations. This trinity is formed by the Sun, Moon, and Ascendant. Every human being in the world carries this characteristic within them. This means that every human being in the world, regardless of culture, race, or belief, is automatically created in the image of God. We are therefore all sons or daughters of God.

What I have experienced is that God is an energy that is intelligent and conscious, capable of taking control of people like puppets with the snap of a finger, and I speak from experience when I say that nobody in the world wants to have God's attention focused on them. God's attention also means having the Devil breathing heavily down your neck. It is a miracle that I am still alive and able to tell this story.

The pattern that was shown to me during a test always took place in three steps and also had a degree of difficulty. It went from normal, to difficult, to easy. It always followed that fixed sequence. This pattern tells me that God consists of three different gods who together form a unity.

Thanks to my knowledge of astrology and the Serpent Bearer, I managed to uncover the identities of these three gods. The pattern of three appeared once again when I began connecting the constellations with numerology. The gods form the final three steps within numerology. We have the combination of 7-8-9: Libra, Scorpio, and the Serpent Bearer. This indicates that 1-2-3 and 4-5-6 also form separate groups. When I discovered

this and began dividing everything according to the 1-4-7, 2-5-8, and 3-6-9 connections, I completely exposed the identity of God. Naturally, I examined everything very critically with a deep character analysis, and it truly falls into place like a puzzle.

The god Vili represents the constellations Aries, Cancer, Libra, Sagittarius, and Pisces. He forms a neutral factor. When I look at this god, Libra is very strongly present in him, purely because of his indecisiveness.

The god Vé represents the constellations Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, and Capricorn. He forms the negative factor. When I look at this god, Scorpio is very strongly present in him, because vengeance, jealousy, and ruthlessness appear to play a central role.

The god Odin represents the constellations Gemini, Virgo, the Serpent Bearer, and Aquarius. He forms the positive factor. When I look at this god, the Serpent Bearer is very strongly present in him, because this constellation is purely centered around occult knowledge and wisdom.

When we talk about cardinal, fixed, and mutable signs, astrology bases these on the seasons. I see this same principle returning in the form of God's identity.

What immediately stands out in this model is that the transition from Pisces to Aries is cardinal twice. This is not a mistake. Cardinal represents the creation of a plan or idea. Two consecutive cardinal constellations strengthen this principle and together form a grand plan. It is the point where closure and a new beginning come together.

## The Creation of Life

When it comes to the creation of life, there is a hint hidden within astrology. What follows is how the gods work together in our material world. This makes visible how the three separate forces together form a single process of creation.

What I have discovered is that Vili comes first. He forms the idea, the plan, and the blueprint. This blueprint is then passed on to Vé, who transforms and materializes the plan. In short, Vé is the one who creates the body based on Vili's instructions.

A body without a soul is what we call dead. It is therefore Odin who gives a soul permission to become part of a body. Odin is the one who brings the body to life by setting it into motion.

As you can see, all three gods together make life possible. All three work together as one unit. One conceives the plan, another gives the plan form, and the other brings the whole thing to life. Without any one of these three steps, life cannot come into existence.

## Hinduism: The Sacred Trinity

I am someone who can have difficulty with existing traditions. That said, when things are good and prove their value, I preserve them completely. I take them with me as knowledge. In this case, I must partially bring Germanic mythology back to life. It turns out that this Germanic trinity is also known in Hinduism. We have the same gods.

Within Hinduism, I see a similar division in the form of the Trimurti, the sacred trinity of Brahma, Shiva, and Vishnu. Vili is equivalent to Brahma, Vé is equivalent to Shiva, and Odin is equivalent to Vishnu.

Brahma is the creator of the manifested world. From primordial consciousness, he brings forth order, structure, and form. Like Vili, he represents intellect, creative thought, and the design upon which all creation is based. Both fulfill the role of cosmic architect.

Shiva is the god of transformation, destruction, and renewal. He breaks down old structures so that new ones can emerge, and helps humanity see through the veil of Maya (illusion). Like Vé, he represents the dynamic force that makes change possible and continually renews creation. Both embody the transition between the old and the new, between form and formlessness.

Vishnu is the preserver of the cosmos and the protector of universal order. He maintains balance within creation and intervenes when that order is disrupted. Like Odin, he represents the animating and sustaining force that carries life, safeguards harmony, and maintains the connection between heaven and Earth.

## The Simulation

I see life as a simulation for the soul. The body we carry as a soul determines which experience we will undergo. If you are born as a bird, you learn to fly, and if you are born as a fish, you learn to swim. When it comes to body and soul, I have already made it clear that memory and thoughts are properties of the soul. The body we carry as a soul

is what contains all the code. It is therefore the body and its hidden code that determine what kind of life experience we undergo and where our abilities lie.

### Freedom is an Illusion

The reason I am aware that we live in a simulation has everything to do with the experiences I have had with clairvoyance. I have experienced this gift in the broadest possible sense of the word.

What you will do one year from now, how you will wake up, what you will eat, who you will meet, what you will say and think: it is all already determined, down to the smallest detail, regardless of the choices you make in the meantime.

The freedom we believe we experience is an illusion. Yet this knowledge does not make me experience life any differently. Even for me, the future remains, and always will remain, one great surprise.

For six years, I struggled with the idea that freedom is an illusion. What makes this particularly remarkable is that I carry the constellation Sagittarius. With this constellation, everything revolves around personal freedom, so perhaps you can understand the inner conflict that immediately arose. How can I, as a Sagittarius, strive for freedom if freedom is an illusion and life consists of a fixed code? That was the moment when I first realized that my pursuit of freedom was an illusion.

At first, I wanted nothing to do with it and pushed the idea away from me. Yet for years I continued searching for some form of freedom, but the deeper I delved into the subject matter, the clearer it became that we are all part of a fixed code.

Is it a bad thing that the future we are heading toward is predetermined?

The answer is no. In fact, it is precisely because life has a fixed direction that it is good. If we were released into the world without any guidance, all the possibilities that exist would prevent us from finding true focus. We could go in every direction, while our time is limited and therefore precious.

Even though we as souls have eternal life, every life experience is temporary. The dimensions in which we exist are, according to my view, all built according to fixed rules and laws. Every dimension has a fixed structure, including the dream world and the afterlife.

Because every life experience is limited in time, we benefit from making the right choices. The path or life experience must proceed efficiently. This is why destiny exists. Destiny carries life lessons with it and gives a person certain qualities with which they can achieve their goals.

If we as human beings want to become good at something, we will have to struggle. The struggle you have to endure gives the achievement its value. The greater the struggle, the

greater the value of what you ultimately achieve. It is primarily the path you travel that forms the ultimate life lesson, not the answer or the achievement itself.

Life therefore does not need to be completely free in order to be valuable. Precisely because life is defined, limited, and unfolds according to a fixed code, every experience gains meaning.

### Destiny

In addition to clairvoyance, there are other sources that indicate that we live according to a fixed code or within a simulation for the soul. When we look at astrology, people speak of destiny. What I experience is that there is a fixed route laid out that you must follow and from which you cannot deviate at all. We are all following a fixed script.

When I look back at the past eighteen years, I can see a clear thread running through my life that constantly keeps directing me back toward discovering my hidden identity. Destiny has repeatedly sent me back to the knowledge of astrology. I repeatedly failed to see what I was supposed to see. Whenever I decided that I wanted nothing to do with it, this urge would turn into a true obsession. Three days later, I would inevitably find myself buried deep in the subject matter once again.

When it comes to the Serpent Bearer and its identity, I keep encountering it by coincidence. In this way, I have managed to develop a broad perspective, shaped purely by intuition and instinct. I always follow my feelings without asking questions.

To discover my hidden identity, I needed the knowledge of astrology and numerology, and I had to build this knowledge from the ground up myself, without any outside help. It has become clear to me that only I am capable of cracking my own hidden code. My entire life is preprogrammed down to the finest details. Everything comes together far too perfectly to be explained as coincidence.

### Numerology

Besides astrology, there is another subject, and that is numerology. Numerology also demonstrates that destiny exists, but at the same time I realize that this is our only form of freedom. You cannot change your date of birth, but you can change the name you carry. While astrology fixes your destiny at the moment you take your first breath, your name contains the strategy with which you intend to approach the chosen destiny. The full name also contains a title, and everyone who lives a successful life actually fulfills this title. It is a kind of hidden aspiration that every human being carries within themselves.

### Neuroscience

In 2008, neuroscientist John-Dylan Haynes conducted an experiment. He had people choose whether to press a button with their left or right hand. Based on patterns in the

brain, the researchers were already able to measure which button the person would press, up to seven seconds before the person consciously made the choice. The brain had already made the decision unconsciously before the conscious thought arose in awareness.

In short, there are three completely different sources to be found: clairvoyance, astrology, and neuroscience, all three indicating that we live in a simulation consisting of a fixed code. There is no freedom of choice. Yet we will notice very little of it ourselves, because the future we are heading toward will always remain a surprise.

## My Communication with God

There is something else I want to make clear: I have never spoken a single word to God. What I want to point out is that the Bible is an exceptionally false scripture. There are important figures who all claim to speak and act on behalf of God.

I find this particularly remarkable because my experience with God was purely cryptic in nature. It was a puzzle, not a direct message conveyed through spoken language. I had to literally experience things myself, and during every encounter I stared death directly in the eyes. My entire environment was manipulated. This pattern even continued deep into my dreams.

I went through every test without ever asking a single question about it. I played along without offering any form of resistance. While I was experiencing this pattern, it never occurred to me that I was in contact with God. I only discovered that many years later, when I came across the Germanic creation story. That was when the pieces finally fell into place.

God is a holy trinity. As human beings, we also carry a holy trinity within us in the form of zodiac signs. Specifically, these are the zodiac signs represented by the Sun, Moon, and Ascendant. The purpose of your life is to bring these three zodiac signs to their fullest potential. Get everything out of them that they have to offer, and make sure that you remain in control of your own life.

## Satan: The Animal Instinct

It is the god Vé who accuses humanity, most likely because of the way we treat other forms of life. This is the god associated with the animal instinct and who sometimes takes on the role of the Devil. According to the scriptures, he has little regard for humanity. He is Satan, meaning “enemy,” the figure referred to in religious texts. He is the Devil I mentioned earlier, the one breathing down your neck during divine contact. He is the one who seizes every opportunity to try to bring you down.



Yet he is not an evil god. He is a god who tests human beings throughout life. If you endure his torment, a reward awaits you at the end. But first, you have to survive it all. With this god, you have to earn his respect.

### My Ode to the Blowfly

All life is part of God's creation. For that reason, I have a great deal of respect for other forms of life—except when it comes to mosquitoes. I realize better than most that we live in a world filled with souls, and that every one of us undergoes a different and unique experience. We all embody the concept of body and soul. I have come to understand that our bodies determine which experience we undergo and where our abilities lie.

The soul and experience of a blowfly are no less valuable than those of a human being. I catch them and release them outside. Souls are not worth more or less than one another. What I am saying is that all life should be approached with respect, even when that blowfly is incredibly annoying. When it starts buzzing, that is actually a sign that it is stressed. It wants nothing more than to get outside, so help it do exactly that.

## Conclusion: God

In this part of the book, I describe my search for the hidden structure behind life, the soul, and God. My search did not begin with a religious conviction, but with my own experiences of clairvoyance, dreams, and events that I personally experienced as supernatural. What repeatedly stood out to me was that events seemed to unfold according to fixed patterns. As I gradually came to understand these experiences better, I developed the idea that life operates according to a fixed code.

# Gifts

## Introduction: Gifts

I have spent eighteen years studying this hidden sign of the Serpent Bearer. After several years, I discovered that I am one myself. The entire code represented by a pure Serpent Bearer is woven into my destiny. My birth chart and the name I carry reveal everything. I am incredibly pure in my construction, and I do not believe in coincidence.

Destiny has sent me in every possible direction, and everywhere I went, I encountered another piece of the puzzle. At first, everything seemed completely disconnected. I had no overview whatsoever. In the beginning, I was completely chaotic, but after rewriting my story over and over again, the underlying thread gradually became clearer.

Over time, all these individual pieces of the puzzle began to form a larger story, a complete whole. I started seeing more and more connections that most experts seem to overlook entirely.

It took me many years to reach this point. My knowledge does not only concern the identity of the Serpent Bearer, but also the afterlife and paranormal abilities. That is where my adventure truly began. I was forced to think about life and, in particular, about everything that might be possible in the hidden background of reality.

These experiences are, incidentally, part of my training as a Serpent Bearer. The defining characteristic is that everything happens to me. When it comes to experiencing paranormal abilities, I have absolutely no control over them myself. I am not a medium. However, every experience I have had in this area forms another piece of the puzzle, showing me what may be possible within our reality.

## Clairvoyance

When it comes to clairvoyance, I have experienced it in the broadest possible sense. I have experienced it in a very direct way, but also symbolically, over both long periods of time and short periods of time. My goal is to make people aware of this existing taboo.

It is clear that many people do not understand what clairvoyance actually is, which means that there are likely many people who possess this ability without even realizing it. When people think of clairvoyance, they immediately turn to the most extreme example. As someone with an aptitude for clairvoyance, I can confirm that experiences in which you perceive a prediction very directly are actually extremely rare.

Another striking aspect is that every clairvoyant experience I have had occurred while I was in a dream state or a temporary trance.

### The Dunes

Let me begin with an example of a metaphorical prediction. When I was very young, around eight years old, I spent a great deal of time with a boy named Lucas. He was exceptionally intelligent for his age and had a broad range of knowledge. We spent a lot of time together during that period, but our contact suddenly came to an end. Before this happened, I experienced a dream that announced everything that was about to happen. For a very long time, it was my worst nightmare. Yet it was not until more than twenty years later, when I analyzed the dream for the first time, that I understood the prediction hidden within it.

In the dream, Lucas and I are walking through nature. We walk through the dunes, and along the way I come across a small lake. At the bottom, I see a body lying there, and I feel an overwhelming urge to help the person. I stop, but Lucas keeps walking. I try to get his attention, but when I attempt to scream, no sound comes out of my throat.

I watch Lucas move through the dunes at an accelerated pace and disappear over the horizon without turning around even once. As Lucas disappears from sight, I decide to dive into the water to save the person. As soon as I reach the body, its eyes suddenly open in the shape of a plus sign and a minus sign. The figure grabs hold of me and then drowns me.

The prediction contained within this message was that our paths would separate because of destiny. Lucas would go his own way, while I would be left behind. During the period in which I experienced this dream, our contact came to an end and we both went our separate ways.

This is therefore an example of a metaphorical prediction. The message itself is direct, but it is distorted through pure symbolism.

## Basketball

My first experience with clairvoyance took place when I was seven years old and playing basketball. In my dream, I saw a teammate standing in a dark environment while performing a very specific dribble. The fragment was brief and lasted approximately three seconds in total.

A year later, the dream became reality. It happened after a training session, while I was waiting for my father. The teammate in question was standing in front of the open doors of the sports hall while the lights were turned off. Out of nowhere, I was overcome by a short but intense trance in which I saw my teammate perform that exact same dribble.

As soon as the fragment ended, I quickly returned to normal consciousness. At that age, I did not think much of it and never told my parents about it. This was a moment in which I was able to perceive the future exactly as it would happen.

I should point out that this direct form is extremely rare. Almost all clairvoyant dreams have a metaphorical or symbolic nature. This childhood dream is still vivid in my memory, just like the nightmare that took place in the dunes.

When it comes to dreams and their predictive abilities, I therefore recommend paying particular attention to dreams that leave a major impact on you after waking up. This allows you to separate the meaningful dreams from the ordinary ones.

## The Daydream

When I was twenty-five, I worked at a post office. One of my responsibilities was emptying mailboxes. During one of these trips, I entered a trance while driving. It was a literal daydream—in other words, a dream that suddenly overtakes you during the day. It is therefore something that actually exists, even though the term is usually used figuratively.

What happened was that I seemed to have a live connection with someone more than thirty kilometers away, and it felt as though I were looking through another person's eyes. This is sometimes referred to as remote viewing.

In this dream, I saw three people in front of me, very vaguely, and the image was in color. Yet I knew exactly who they all were. They were verbally fighting, and I had the feeling that the situation was about to get out of control. During the fragment, I had a strong intuition that the boy wanted to throw a stone through the windows.

When the dream fragment ended, I woke up in the middle of a slight bend in the road.

What was particularly strange was that I kept repeating the exact same sentence out loud, over and over again, almost like a madman:

“Man, you shouldn’t do that! Man, you shouldn’t do that!”



It was as if I were trying to talk the boy out of throwing the stone.

Shortly after this experience, I had already forgotten everything and continued driving as if nothing had happened. Just like with a normal dream, the memory disappeared immediately after waking up.

When I arrived home from work, I received a phone call. I was told that her sister had gotten into an argument with her boyfriend and that the situation had escalated. That was also the moment when I remembered the daydream.

I told her what had happened and warned her that he wanted to throw a stone through the window. Because it had not happened yet, she laughed it off as nonsense.

Two days later, a stone was indeed thrown through the window.

This experience is particularly remarkable because it was the first and only time that several alarm bells went off simultaneously. It was an experience in which I seemed to witness something live that was taking place more than thirty kilometers away.

There were several distinct elements to the experience:

1. I saw the fragment in color, but the image in front of me was extremely blurry.
2. I had the intuition that the boy wanted to throw a stone through the windows, and this intuition came through my solar plexus.
3. Internally, I was repeatedly saying the same sentence out loud, as if I were trying to talk the boy out of doing it.

While driving, I went onto automatic pilot and woke up halfway through a slight bend in the road. I have no memory of the road I traveled, simply because I did not consciously experience it.

This experience also indicates to me that fate exists and that our bodies are programmed in advance, as discussed in the previous chapter: The Simulation.

### The Fair

This is one of the coolest experiences I have ever had. It happened when I was twenty-one. There was a fair in the city, and I had two young boys with me who wanted to go there. Both were around twelve years old.

One of them wanted to go on the bumper cars. It is the place where the so-called tough guys always seem to gather. I already had a bad feeling about it, so I decided to go with the boy.

It happened during the third round. He was happily driving around until two seventeen-year-old boys suddenly decided to drive in the opposite direction and, without any reason whatsoever, hit this twelve-year-old boy directly in the face.

I was sitting next to him and was completely stunned and furious with anger. When the ride ended, I headed straight toward my target. Before I knew it, I was surrounded by an entire group.

The only thing I remember is being pushed, falling off the platform, and landing on the hood of a parked car nearby.

At that moment, something extraordinary happened. I thought back to the time when I had been beaten up by an entire group of people over something that had never happened. I had promised myself then that I would never allow that to happen again and that from that point forward, I would fight back.

The moment I decided to confront them was the moment when my vision briefly went black, after which I immediately entered a short trance.

During this trance, I saw exactly what my opponent was doing and how I would respond, down to the smallest detail. Everything appeared in sharp, full-color imagery, and each trance lasted approximately three seconds.

When the trance ended, my body carried out exactly what I had just seen, on automatic pilot. Once that event was over, the next trance began.

Every trance was one hundred percent accurate.

In total, I entered a trance three or four times in succession, while my body automatically fought without any conscious influence from me. At the time, I thought I possessed some kind of superpower. I assumed that I had discovered a hidden mode within my body.

Today, however, I understand it very differently.

In hindsight, I believe that my guide literally took control of my body. He fought on my behalf and used his abilities to do so. All I did was deliver the blows. I did not have to take a single one myself.

At that moment, I felt like the master of the situation. My guide first showed me the future, after which my body carried it out.

Once again, this was a sign to me that the future is fixed down to the smallest detail. But it was not only the future that seemed to be manipulated, the experience also suggested that time itself had been manipulated.

Another remarkable aspect of this unique experience is that each trance lasted approximately three seconds.

This means that I experienced literally three seconds of time within a fraction of a millisecond. The world around me seemed to have been temporarily frozen, at least that

is how it felt. As a result of this experience, I am twelve to fifteen seconds older than I should actually be.

I have now shared three different forms of clairvoyant ability. There is an experience involving the long term, a live connection, and an experience of short-term clairvoyance. Of course, I have many more experiences, but these are the three that have left the greatest impression on me. Now I want to move on to another gift, known as claircognizance.

## Claircognizance

When it comes to having spiritual gifts, they never exist on their own. If someone possesses a spiritual gift, they usually have two or more gifts. When it comes to claircognizance, I can say that it is my guide who communicates a direct message to me. It is not a voice inside my head or a thought; it is an inner voice that comes from the solar plexus. I personally think this is a wonderful gift to have, and I have experienced many extraordinary moments because of it.

## Covid

My last intense experience with claircognizance was on January 19, 2020, when I immediately knew that the coronavirus was a biological weapon. This made me immediately aware that the disease had escaped from a laboratory and that the scapegoat that was supposed to take the blame was the meat market. I have seen many organizations lie blatantly in order to suppress the truth. I was able to experience everything directly, and I am extremely aware that, as a society, we are not entitled to the truth. We are deliberately kept ignorant in many situations.

It also indicates that they knew very well what had actually happened and did everything they could to keep it secret. You were apparently allowed to have the strangest suspicions about COVID, but saying that it had come from a laboratory was subject to censorship. This therefore indicates where the real sensitive point lay, and my guide has never deceived me.

## Whoever Laughs Last...

I have had several experiences with claircognizance, and I will share my favorite one with you. It was during a time when I was still manic, and I had been invited to a birthday party. After the birthday party, we went out and ended up in a large bar. I remember standing there quietly by myself when I saw an old schoolmate standing with a very beautiful girl. They were clearly dating, yet I did not have a good relationship with that guy. That became clear when we made eye contact and he decided to walk over to me.

I do not remember exactly what he said to me, but I remember my own response very clearly. He was insulting me to impress the girl, and out of nowhere I was taken over by a feeling of complete calm. I was completely relaxed in a way I had rarely experienced

before. I was completely zen. Instead of making a shitty remark in return, I calmly said to him:

"I see that you're out with another very nice girl again. The thing is, though, you never take them home. If you don't make a move on this girl tonight, she'll slip right through your fingers."

These words came completely out of nowhere. Once again, it was my guide who took control by briefly and subtly taking over. After I said it, there was a moment when I had to let it all sink in, yet my intuition immediately told me that everything would turn out exactly right. Because of that, I was instantly filled with confidence.

I remember that guy looking at me, laughing at me, and walking back to the girl to tell her everything. She also looked at me as if I had completely lost my mind. I smiled back at her kindly, completely confident. I already had a strong feeling that something was going to happen. It was not the first time I had experienced something like this, and the past had shown that my guide was always right.

An hour later, we were in a nightclub. I was standing against a pole, casually looking around, and that guy was standing next to me with the girl. I saw him go to get drinks, and that was the moment when someone from the birthday party came over to me and, in a drunken moment of complete openness, asked me for advice. He told me that he was crazy about a girl and did not know what to do. I advised him that he should not be telling me about it, but should instead tell the girl he was crazy about. He looked me straight in the eyes and said, "You're absolutely right." Out of nowhere, he walked over to that guy's girl and started intensely kissing her. I did not see that guy for the rest of the night.

My prediction had come true, without me realizing that I would actually play a role in making it happen. However, that girl spent the entire evening staring at me while she was kissing him, with a genuine WTF look in her eyes.

Naturally, I smiled back at her kindly.

### My First Experience

When I was around nineteen years old, I had my first experience with claircognizance. I remember very clearly that I was sitting at my computer when, all of a sudden, I started thinking about an old female classmate. I had not seen or spoken to her for a year and a half. At the same time, I got the feeling that she was going to call me. Not even ten seconds later, my phone rang and she was on the other end of the line. I found this so remarkable that I decided to tell my mother about it. She did not think much of it, and I walked back upstairs. As I reached the top of the stairs, I received another intuition.

This time, my feeling told me that my mother was going to receive a call from a specific friend. Without any hesitation, I immediately shared this with my mother, who was still

standing at the bottom of the stairs. I said to my mother, "You're going to get a call from that specific friend," at which point my mother looked at me and laughed, holding the phone in her hands. Three seconds passed, and suddenly the phone rang with a withheld number. When my mother answered the phone, that specific friend was on the other end of the line.

## Clairsentience

When it comes to clairsentience, I do not know whether I am dealing with a gift or a curse. In the past, I was switched on nonstop for three months and was driven completely insane mentally. I was in love, but the person I was in love with had been lying about everything from the very beginning. My guide spent three months warning me about her. Even my dreams were giving me very direct indications of what was going on. However, I wanted nothing to do with it.

## Emotional Distance

What I mean by being switched on is that I continuously knew what she was up to, from more than 35 kilometers away. If she traveled into the city by train, my intuition would give me a signal. I would then be bold enough to call her and tell her that she was on the train, which was always confirmed. If she was standing somewhere kissing another guy, I would receive a direct signal about that as well. The latter, however, was something she did very often, a different guy every weekend. It was destroying me, but because I was in love, I wanted nothing to do with it the entire time. I consciously ignored all the signals out of pure stubbornness.

Three months later, when the truth finally came out and all the lies became clear, I realized that my guide had done everything he could to warn me. He had literally pulled out all the stops to keep me away from her. Ever since then, I have taken every piece of advice I receive extremely seriously. The end result at the time, however, was that I was mentally completely broken and exhausted by a gift that I could not switch off.

## Aura

A subject that I personally found vague for a long time was the so-called aura. In hindsight, I also know why. If your aura is functioning properly, it means that it effectively blocks other energies from outside. You do not experience any differences. Because of this, it is difficult for many people to perceive that it exists.

I can guarantee you that after my mental breakdown, I began to experience the aura. I am not the only one either; everyone who has experienced a mental breakdown carries an aura that is susceptible to others. It is a very striking characteristic within mental healthcare, because I encountered many people there in whom this was clearly apparent.

I have been in contact with mental healthcare for many years. During appointments and courses, I was surrounded by many mentally ill people with the most diverse problems. What they all have in common is that when I am manic, I drive everyone around me completely insane. In that case, I am the transmitter rather than the receiver. Even when I am sitting completely calmly and behaving in an entirely peaceful manner, people can feel my intense energy. They often point out to me that I am too much for them, even though I literally do not move a muscle. It shows that most people experience my inner energy as a burden. It is always in motion. I am restlessness itself.

During a period when I was still regularly manic, it also happened that I temporarily began carrying the mental illness of someone else. If I had someone around me who was completely unstable, my body would take over that energy. This is also a part of clairsentience. The result was that I became completely restless and spiraled out of control, to such an extent that I could no longer eat, sleep, or sit still. I became extremely restless. Yet when I woke up the next day, I had cleansed myself. Sleeping it off is the only remedy.

## Final Conclusion: Gifts

As you can see, I have experienced quite a few things in the field of spirituality that are beyond the grasp of most people. I carry many answers with me, but I am always searching for the reason behind everything. A subject does not truly rest in my mind until I have analyzed it completely, down to the very core, and all of my questions have been answered.

Clairvoyance has shown me that the future we are heading toward is already fixed, down to the smallest detail. When it comes to claircognizance and clairsentience, these are also gifts that are directly connected to the dimension of the afterlife. Communication with my guide takes place through the solar plexus, dreams, or through a short but intense trance.

When it comes to my guide, I know very little about his or her identity. All I know is that it is a force that always helps me when things cannot possibly get any worse. It is also always right and passes along information that I am not actually supposed to know. What I find so remarkable about my relationship with my guide is that my guide has permission to temporarily take over my body, in intense and sometimes subtle ways. My guide has the ability to bend time and has also demonstrated clairvoyant abilities. During that fight at the fair, my guide completely took over my body immediately after everything went black for me.

When I look back at everything, it is clear that a battle was taking place in the background. When I was switched on for three months through my feelings and connected to another person, I believe that a spiritual battle had broken out. There was an energy doing everything it could to push me toward her, while another energy in the background was doing everything it could to keep me away from her. The latter party would ultimately emerge as the winner when the truth finally came to light after three months.

In addition to my experiences with paranormal gifts, I have also had various experiences with the afterlife. These are two separate parts of my life. In the next section, I describe my experiences with the afterlife.



# Afterlife

## My Experiences with the Afterlife

When I look back on everything, the first hints I received about the existence of psychic abilities and the afterlife came when I was nineteen years old. I was going through a period in which my parents were getting divorced, and that too would become a highly influential element in my life. I was finally free from the pressure my father had constantly put on me to study. I was finally free from his dominance. After my parents' divorce, things gradually began to unfold.

### The Shadow Man

When I was about twenty-one years old, my uncle passed away. I decided to temporarily move into his apartment with a few friends until it was sold.

It was during the European Football Championship, and we decided to smoke a joint with the group while watching television. I quickly became stoned, and to me it felt as though I had entered some kind of 1970s atmosphere. The football footage I saw on television had that distinctive style.

I soon became tired and decided to close my eyes. The moment I closed them, I heard an extremely loud, screaming sound in my right ear. It sounded a lot like someone using a gas burner to lay a roof, but even rougher and more chaotic. Looking back now, it sounded very much like intense static.

I immediately opened my eyes and looked at the person sitting next to me. He was so intensely focused on the match that I quickly thought to myself: whatever! Immediately afterward, I closed my eyes again, and once more, at the exact moment I closed them, I heard that same sound screaming in my right ear. I opened my eyes again and looked to my right, where I saw a pitch-black figure standing there with the silhouette of a man. He was standing in the doorway, and although he had no physical features, I somehow knew that he was staring at me. When I saw him, I immediately pointed at the demon and drew the rest of the group's attention to it. Of course, they saw nothing and, as usual, laughed it off. Not long afterward, my roommates would also come into contact with this demon.

A few months later, while they were asleep, one of them suddenly woke up in the middle of the night. She heard a strange sound coming from the kitchen and went to investigate. When she arrived, the gas stove was turned on full blast, and the oven was switched on and left open. This demon had literally attempted to blow up the entire apartment building.

What was particularly remarkable during that period was that I often woke up with sleep paralysis while staying there. During the time I lived in that apartment, this happened at least four times. Yet the penny still did not drop; I never thought much of it and simply went back to sleep.

It was December, and I remember that the temperature was far below freezing, accompanied by a harsh, bitterly cold wind. The apartment had been sold, and I no longer had most of my belongings, including the television. The only thing I still had was an old radio, and the problem was that I could only receive foreign stations that played nothing but deeply depressing music. In that sense, the atmosphere had already partly been set.

On top of that, I did everything I could to make the house warmer. I had the heating turned all the way up, the curtains closed to keep the cold out, and I had even lit several candles. No matter what I did, the living room kept getting colder.

At one point, it became so cold that I put on my winter coat; I am not exaggerating when I say that I could see the steam coming from my mouth. I was sitting on a bench next to the window when, out of nowhere, I was overcome by a storm of emotions. I felt fear, sadness, loneliness, homesickness, anger, and depression, all at the same time.

I can tell you that I immediately felt as though I was mentally losing my mind completely. Within seconds, I became completely insane and fled the house, never to return. Yet my contact with the demon would not end there.

### The Two Labradors

A year later, my roommates moved into an apartment together. There, they experimented with taking photographs of so-called orbs (balls of energy). During this experiment, they captured something very remarkable. They managed to photograph two dogs, a black Labrador and a blonde Labrador, in full color. They were the dogs she had owned during her childhood.

This confirms the fact that these orbs represent actual souls and are not particles of dust, as science claims. The light-colored Labrador was lying across her lap and looking directly into the camera. If you looked even more closely, you could see the black Labrador sitting behind her, with its head visible above her shoulder. This dog was also looking directly into the camera.

When I saw the results of their experiment, that was the moment when the penny finally dropped for me: the afterlife actually exists.

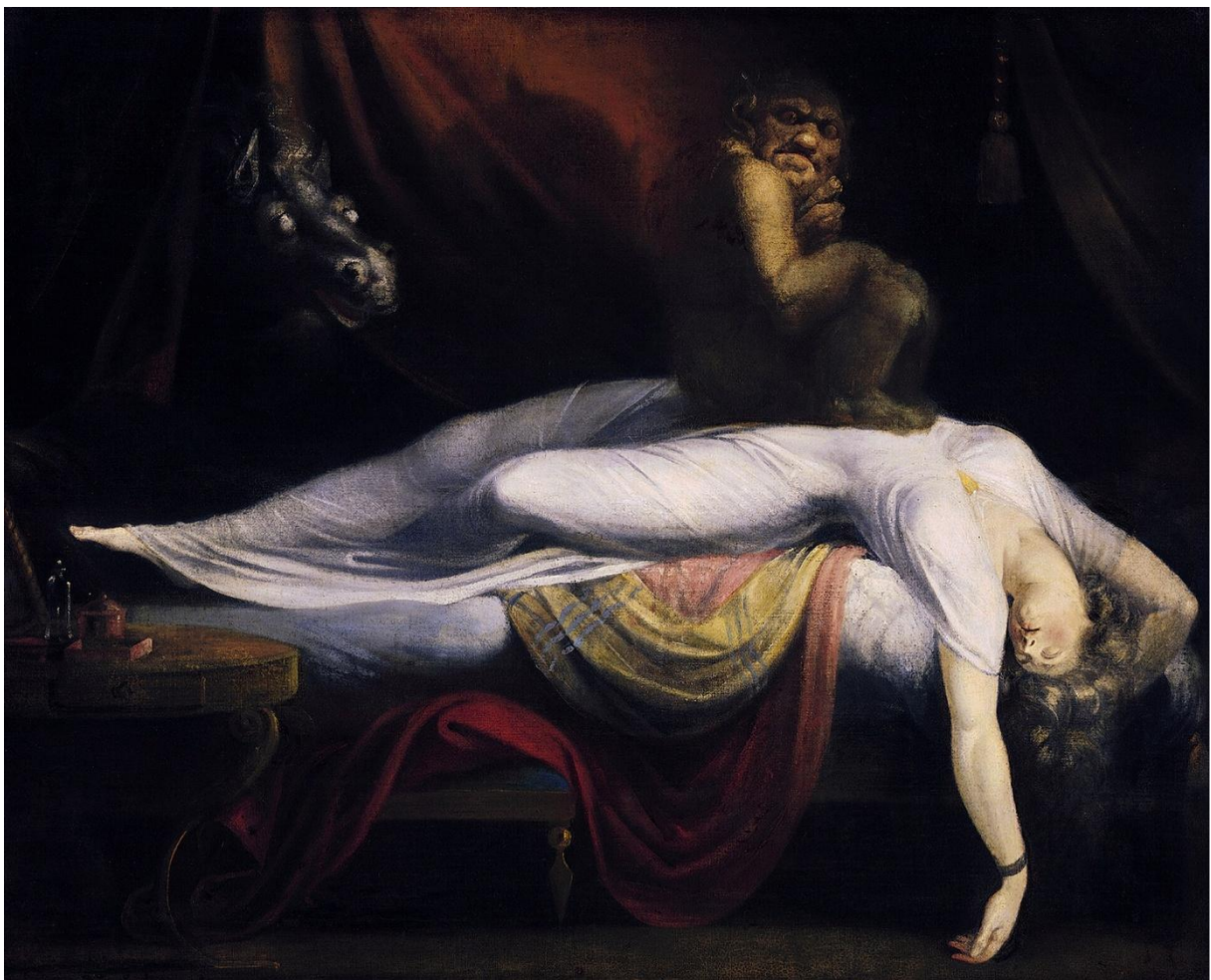
### Sleep Paralysis (The Mare)

Several years later, I woke up in sleep paralysis again, but this time everything was different. I woke up lying on my back and could literally feel someone sitting on top of my abdomen. I could feel the full weight resting on me, but I could not see anything with my eyes. At the same time, I was grabbed by the wrists and pinned down against the mattress. So much adrenaline was rushing through my body that I put all the strength I had into lifting my right arm. Very slowly, I managed to raise it farther and farther away from the mattress, until the moment I finally broke completely free from the paralysis

and shot upright. The weight was gone, and I immediately ran out of the bed. This would be the last episode of sleep paralysis I would ever experience.

The Mare is a figure from Germanic folklore that was said to sit on people while they slept at night. It appears during sleep. It sits on the chest or abdomen of a sleeping person. The victim is unable to move (sleep paralysis). People often experience a feeling of suffocation or intense pressure on the chest. There is also often an intense feeling of fear or an evil presence.

What I can say about the Mare is that it must have been a small creature. If it had been a person of normal height sitting on top of me and grabbing me by the wrists, that person would have been sitting at the level of my groin. This creature was sitting on my abdomen with its arms stretched out. In other words, the Mare must have been a small creature.



### The Poltergeist

When I was in the middle of the transformation process, I was filled with extreme anger because of all the incomprehension I encountered. Nobody listened to me, and

everyone declared me crazy during that period, because doing so is easier than facing the confrontation head-on. I was always in my bedroom, like a true recluse, and the negative energy resulting from my anger began to accumulate. At some point, this energy became so powerful that it literally began to lead a life of its own. This is something they refer to in the paranormal world as “residual energy.”

My energy manifested itself as a poltergeist. Whenever I turned off the television, the whole scene would begin. I would hear static discharges coming from my computer, wardrobe, radio, television, and the wooden ceiling directly above my head where I slept. It always happened in exactly that fixed sequence.

This had been going on for three months when I finally discovered that there was always a fixed pattern to it. The very next evening, I immediately decided to test it. It was the evening immediately afterward. I turned off the television and immediately heard a static discharge coming from my computer.

I immediately said, “Now the wardrobe!” and a knock followed instantly. It went through the entire sequence. It went from my computer to the wooden wardrobe, radio, television, and every time I gave it a command, it was answered immediately. When I reached the final step, the ceiling directly above my head, there was a moment when it sounded as though someone had taken a full swing with a sledgehammer. It was an enormous bang that reverberated throughout the entire house.

I immediately sat upright in my bed, purely out of shock, but instead of fear, I was overwhelmed by a feeling of pure anger, deep from within my heart. I said to the poltergeist: “I am not afraid of you. When I die, I will be just like you, and then you’ll be fucking mine!” I meant every word I said. I never heard anything from it again after that.

### **I See, I See, What You Don’t Want to See...**

As a final point, I would like to mention something that I personally consider very important. During the period when I was staying in that apartment, I also had an experience with the afterlife in which a very large group of people was present. We were all sitting around talking peacefully when, out of nowhere, I saw a planter fall over, even though nobody was anywhere near it. What makes the situation even stranger is that the planter was standing on the floor. That was not all; the container filled with soil was so heavy compared to the plant inside it that it would have been impossible for the planter to tip over by itself.

When this happened, the entire living room was startled. Everyone looked at it, and for a second there was complete silence. Then everyone carried on as though nothing had happened. I was the only person in the living room who actually understood what was happening at that moment.

In 2020, I also had an experience in which exactly the same thing happened. I was sitting in a room with three other people, and there was a cabinet standing opposite us. A shuffleboard was leaning diagonally against this cabinet. I was talking with these people when, out of nowhere, the shuffleboard fell diagonally in the opposite direction. Once again, there was absolutely nobody near it; we were the only people present in the room. I immediately realized that what had happened was completely impossible, and I realized that I had once again attracted the attention of the afterlife. Yet once again, exactly the same thing happened. Everyone looked at it and saw it happen, but a few seconds later they continued as though nothing had happened. In this case too, everyone immediately switched into denial mode.

My message is very clear. It is time for you to start paying much closer and sharper attention to everything happening around you and give it the attention it deserves, instead of automatically burying your head in the sand whenever you are mentally challenged. When I look at this behavior, I personally think that many people do have experiences, but continually and consciously walk away from them as a form of self-protection.

## Final Conclusion: The Afterlife

As you can see, when it came to the afterlife, I was thrown straight into the deep end. I immediately attracted the attention of the worst kind. I encountered a demon that clearly took the form of a male figure. If I had to estimate his height, he was almost two meters tall. He had pitch-black energy that blocked out every form of light, creating a striking contrast. This is the being that attempted to blow up the apartment building and manipulated my emotions. Its presence was precisely what caused the icy coldness in the living room, with steam literally coming from my mouth.

The photograph showing the two dogs was, for me, the piece of information I had been searching for all along. As a true animal lover, I could not believe that animals had no afterlife, as some religions claim. That photograph was the proof that animals also pass on to what is known as the heavenly paradise, and that was the moment when the penny finally dropped for me. I became aware.

However, I have some very sad news regarding that photograph. My friends at the time had absolutely no understanding of its actual value. They had the ultimate piece of evidence in their hands, something many paranormal researchers would have killed for. Apparently, they did not consider the digital photographs important enough and therefore deleted them.

What I personally find most remarkable is my experience with the Mare. This creature belongs to Germanic folklore, and I can confirm that this small creature exists. The question that remains open to me now is: how much more of the ancient Germanic folklore is actually true?

You may also have noticed that every time I become angry with the beings in the afterlife, the activity stops immediately afterward. My threats are taken very seriously. In the chapter about the Serpent Bearer, I shared my birth chart with you. I explained that I am connected to the instruments of the Egyptian Ma'at. I am therefore the Anubis type, a true psychopomp. My experiences with the afterlife seem to confirm this theory.

Originally, I am therefore a personality who guides souls through the afterlife and brings them to their final destination. I strongly suspect, purely because the afterlife keeps seeking me out, that the beings from the afterlife are more familiar with my status and reputation than I am myself. They already knew who I was all along, long before I would uncover it for myself.



# The Wounded Healer

## My Struggle with Bipolar Disorder

After I finished my studies at a university of applied sciences, a different period of my life began. During that time, I became deeply involved with the afterlife and paranormal abilities, as you have read. These experiences constantly intertwined with one another. Every experience I had forced me to think deeply about life. I eventually reached a point where I had had enough of all the lies. People had always told me that paranormal abilities did not exist, and the same was said about the afterlife. Yet I experienced the exact opposite.

I became so incredibly angry that I decided to go for a complete reset. I threw away everything I thought I knew and started with a clean slate. I was so furious that I screamed at myself in a mirror: "I want nothing else, absolutely nothing else, but to know the fucking truth!" I can tell you that I managed to curse myself, especially because those words came straight from the heart. I meant every single word, and I would get exactly what I had asked for. Not long after that moment, I would enter what is known as a thought flight.

### The First Phase: The Cause of the Thought Flight

At that point in my life, I was so obsessed with the afterlife and paranormal abilities that I had immersed myself in all kinds of mysterious subjects. By literally going through a reset, I had activated my brain; it behaved like a dry sponge. Everything I learned was absorbed and stored. Reading something once was enough for me to know it.

In a period of less than a week, I absorbed so much information that my brain went into conflict. The information I was taking in was no longer being transferred to my long-term memory. My short-term memory became overloaded, and the result was that the information continued circling endlessly through my head. It became so intense that the only way to release this tension was by talking endlessly in gibberish. It was my only outlet. Yet I was not insane. My body was completely out of control due to the extreme overload combined with total exhaustion, leaving me unable to behave normally. Still, I experienced everything around me with complete awareness. I watched many relationships fall apart because exhaustion had left me without any ability to put the brakes on my own behavior.

If I have to describe a thought flight, I would say that it is an illness that consumes an enormous amount of energy. While I was already exhausted from burnout, I developed another condition on top of it that did everything it could to drain my body even further. My body was essentially capable of producing 3 volts, while the thought flight constantly demanded 7 volts. I was therefore being pushed to the absolute limit and beyond. Thoughts also race through your head endlessly and restlessly. They literally fly past at tremendous speed. The moment I had spoken the first sentence was the moment another story had already begun inside my head. I was also unable to tell a story

chronologically; all the information was disorganized inside my brain. It was complete chaos.

When it comes to understanding a thought flight, I have the perfect metaphor. A computer has short-term memory and long-term memory. First, information enters the short-term memory (working memory), after which it is transferred to the long-term memory (the hard drive). During a thought flight, that process breaks down. The short-term memory no longer transfers information to the long-term memory, causing everything to continue accumulating in the short-term memory. The result is that your thoughts bounce through your head at incredible speed, faster than you can keep up with through speech. There is not a single moment of peace. The little information that did get through was not stored chronologically. Everything was fragmented. I could no longer tell a story properly.

I spent a year and a half running on high voltage without a moment of rest. I was experiencing burnout, but nobody saw it. I remember the day I recovered from my thought flight very clearly. I was sitting on a train when I ran into an old friend. I started talking to him, but as usual, I fell into a torrent of speech combined with complete restlessness. I can tell you that everyone in the carriage was driven crazy by my behavior. I watched yet another relationship fall apart right in front of my eyes. When I got off the train, I felt deeply ashamed of the way I had behaved. I had had enough.

I then went to work, and during the afternoon I suddenly experienced a very strong inner feeling coming from my solar plexus. It told me that I needed to go home and write down my thought flight. I recognized this feeling from previous experiences. This feeling had always been right, so I saw no reason to distrust it. I immediately went to my manager and went home.

When I arrived home, I immediately started up my computer. I opened a blank document, but before I began, I made myself a solemn promise: everything I wrote down was allowed to be forgotten. This was the key to my success. I started typing like a madman, nonstop, without looking at what I was writing. I tried to keep up with every thought racing through my head like a high-speed train. The only thing I know is that at some point I managed to calm this inner storm with the force of a hurricane. After writing twelve full pages of complete gibberish, I decided to close the document. After a year and a half of suffering, I had finally managed to find some peace in my head again. Yet I was not completely healed.

The following day, the same thing happened. I was back at work and my mind was busy again. Once more, that same feeling came with the same message. I went home without asking permission and made myself the same promise again, allowing myself to let go of everything and forget it all. This time, fifteen pages of gibberish came out, and after closing the document, I had healed myself from the thought flight. In total, I had 27

pages of information racing around in my short-term memory. It is therefore no wonder that I had lost control of my own brain.

Yet things were no longer the same. Before the thought flight, I was someone with a busy mind. I could lie in bed for hours, endlessly fantasizing about everything. Ever since I closed that document, my mind has been completely silent. There are no thoughts or spontaneity anymore. Everything is quiet. In short: I went from one extreme to the other. From a state of complete overload to a state of complete silence.

### The Second Phase: Depression

Immediately after the thought flight, I fell into a severe depression. At that time, I was striving for a normal life and had developed an aversion to the afterlife and paranormal abilities. I wanted to live like everyone else, without constantly being labeled as strange. I ran away from my own destiny and managed to keep doing so for four years. When I turned thirty, I reached the point where I could no longer go on. I had had enough of the depression.

I remember waking up one morning with a very strong inner feeling. It was the same feeling I had experienced during those moments with the thought flight. This time, it told me that I needed to learn how to bring my three astrological signs—the Sun, Moon, and Ascendant—together as a single team. When it came to astrology, I had already reached the point where I was ready to abandon the subject completely, and I decided to give astrology one final chance. It was an all-or-nothing moment.

At that time, things were still simple. I was only familiar with my duality between Sagittarius and Scorpio, while my Ascendant was completely foreign to me. When I looked back at my behavior, it immediately became clear to me that I was constantly switching between Scorpio and Sagittarius; both were fighting for the same position. My Gemini Ascendant literally had no right to exist because it was completely pushed aside by the intensity of my duality.

Once I realized this, I brought all three signs together and gave them a common purpose. My Sagittarius is very good at gathering knowledge and loves adventure and mystery. My Scorpio is the part of me that exposes everything down to the root. It is my detective who uncovers every secret. My Gemini is the communicator and analyst who wants to understand the why behind everything. Together, they form a team capable of uncovering mysteries and exposing their secrets.

The moment I decided to go through life as a paranormal investigator was the first moment in my life when I embraced my own identity and destiny. For the first time in my life, I had a real purpose: uncovering the hidden reality. When I reached this conclusion, something extraordinary happened: my four-year depression disappeared as if someone had simply flipped a switch and turned the light back on.

My emotional state went from severe depression to completely normal; the difference was so radical and intense that it almost seemed as if I had never been depressed at all. Once again, I went radically from one extreme to the other. The effect was immediate, and ever since then I have not experienced a single day of depression. At that moment, I accepted my destiny and finally found a purpose in life. My knowledge of astrology would prove itself in practice by healing me from a four-year depression. It was after this moment that everything finally began to accelerate at incredible speed.

### The Third Phase: Mania

Once the depression was definitively over, a three-year period of manic episodes began. They came and went. During that time, I learned that mania can be managed by recognizing the condition early and preventing exhaustion. In the beginning, the manic episodes were long and intense; sometimes they could last an entire week. Yet over time, the periods became shorter and less powerful. When I turned 33, the manic phases came to an end. Since then, I have rarely experienced mania. There have been two minor moments in which I temporarily lost control, but for the most part, I am once again standing firmly with both feet on the ground.

What is particularly remarkable about mania is that during these periods, you can be strongly influenced by the phases of the Moon. For example, when there was a full moon, I could feel enormous amounts of energy flooding through my body. At midnight, I would be filled with life energy and could literally feel my body tingling. It happened many times that I experienced this sensation and then looked outside, only to have it confirmed: it was always a full moon.

Mania also has an entirely different side. Ever since that mental breakdown caused by the thought flight, my aura has changed. An aura is supposed to protect the body against influences from other people's energy. After the thought flight, my aura transformed from a protector into a receiver and transmitter.

When I am manic and my energy is running high, healthy people around me can even sense my inner restlessness. I am someone who cannot experience inner peace. It is a burden I carry with me. I am simply too much for most people and sometimes drive them crazy simply by being near them; nothing more is required.

### Illusion

Now it is time to be open and honest about myself as well. One thing is certain: I am not perfect. On paper, I am in a bad state. I may have overcome bipolar disorder, but it still represents my weakness. During a manic phase, I often see deep connections that do not actually exist. Your brain becomes so deeply absorbed in a particular subject that other people can have difficulty following you as well.

There was a time, for example, when I believed I could recognize zodiac signs in songs. At the time, I was making an entire list. I was absolutely convinced that I was right. However, three months later, when I read it again, I realized that I had simply had a weak moment. The advantage of mania is that these kinds of illusions become clear in hindsight. In the past, I have often been wrong about things, but I have always continued striving for perfection and the ultimate truth.

I have also noticed that with every new discovery, I become completely obsessed with it, with all my passion. Even then, I can sometimes lose sight of reality, but fortunately, this too is temporary. Some things simply need time to sink into the bigger picture. I have a tendency to want to write an entirely new book with every new discovery. The thing is, however, that I had already started writing when my training as a pure Serpent Bearer had only just begun. I still had everything to discover, yet I had already started writing the final exam. That is why I have rewritten this book more than thirty times already. The book is never finished...

### Final Conclusion: The Wounded Healer

By listening to my inner feelings and following the advice of my guide, I learned how to fight my mental illness. Bipolar disorder forced me to grow up very quickly. Throughout this process, I had to suffer for nine years because of an inner conflict taking place between my zodiac signs. I was pierced by my own spear. What is also remarkable is that, after all the suffering, I managed to acquire the hidden knowledge of the runes, just like Odin. We both carry the same destiny.

Whereas I once possessed a form of elitist intelligence, I am now someone who can appreciate everyone and everything in life. I have let go of my competitive drive. I went from being someone who had absolutely no idea who he was to someone who knows himself down to the bone. My old behavior first had to completely fall apart to make room for a simpler being, one who possesses more sympathy, understanding, and wisdom.

There is also another side to my story. For around thirty years, I wandered through life without a purpose. I never knew what I wanted to become, so I never had anything to live for. Since overcoming my illness, I have finally found a purpose in life. I have given myself the mission of explaining reality in its entirety, and I believe I have already made considerable progress.

## Conclusion: The Serpent Bearer

In this part of the book, I have focused entirely on the life of a Serpent Bearer. In doing so, I have given this zodiac sign a place once again. After restoring the Serpent Bearer, I saw the possibility of discussing the identity of God. The Serpent Bearer plays a highly decisive role in this. Without the Serpent Bearer, you cannot uncover the identity of God.

I myself possess the structure of a pure Serpent Bearer. When it comes to possessing paranormal abilities, I refer to my Neptune in the 8th House within astrology. It is this specific placement that indicates whether someone has an inherent predisposition. I am merely confirming what astrology claims by sharing my experiences. In doing so, I am also trying to demonstrate that destiny actually exists and that astrology can be an exact science.

We are all following a script, a code hidden within the body. Freedom is an illusion, as three completely different sources collectively indicate. We simultaneously live in three different dimensions, and each dimension is shaped by a separate god. Each dimension has its own laws, rules, and way of being experienced.

When it comes to zodiac signs or dimensions, we are connected to God at all times. As human beings, we possess a sacred trinity just as God does. These three zodiac signs represent your entire being. By giving these zodiac signs the proper respect and consciously taking control of them, you honor God. As written on the Temple of Apollo: 'Know thyself.'

Now that this first part is complete and finished, I will turn my attention to the knowledge of numerology. Astrology alone does not determine that I have the status of a psychopomp. There are many more people around the world who, just like me, were born under the same planetary placements. So the question remains: what makes me different?

The secret lies in the name I carry.

## The Birth of the Formula

When I was 33, there was a support worker who tried to help me with writing my book. When I told her that I was involved in astrology, she introduced me to numerology for the first time. Immediately after the appointment, I ordered two books, which I then studied only superficially. I soon came to the conclusion that both books used the same formulas, yet their explanations contradicted each other. This gave me the impression that the authors had no real understanding of the true identity of numbers.

However, one of the books contained a technique in which the idea was to count how often each number appeared in your name. After flipping through the book, I became fixated on this method because my intuition immediately told me that the method was incomplete. I then spent five hours impulsively trying to restore the original formula in its entirety. In doing so, I took all the laws of the universe into account. The formula I discovered at that time forms the foundation of my work.

During that period, I also discovered many other techniques. It was only many years later that I realized that one of those techniques perfectly complements the basic model. This technique always supplements the base values in a positive way. When the two results are combined, it becomes visible how you score in each zodiac sign. It reveals the relationships between them and the qualities of a person. My method, which I call the Formula of Odin, therefore consists of these two different calculation techniques.

## A Different Approach

In modern numerology, it is often claimed that a master number must always consist of three identical digits. This is an incorrect assumption; my formula shows that a master number already exists when there are two consecutive identical digits. In other words, a matching pair is already enough to constitute a master number. Another incorrect assumption that I need to address directly is the idea that numerology is based solely on addition. My technique uses both addition and multiplication.

In the chapter on the Serpent Bearer, I demonstrated why this sign is still an essential part of astrology and numerology. I apply this same method as I do with the elements. This means that Aries corresponds to Sagittarius, Taurus to Capricorn, Gemini to Aquarius, and Cancer to Pisces. The numbers 1 through 4 therefore carry a dual identity.

Finally, I want to emphasize that numerology (the knowledge of the runes) relates exclusively to the alphabet and therefore to names. It does not relate to your date of birth. If you want to perform a numerological calculation based on your date of birth, I recommend consulting Chinese astrology.

I use a simple method to assign a title to a name, based on the name value and the total letter value. I convert the values of the name into zodiac signs, which then produces a

kind of title. What I have discovered after performing many calculations is that almost all successful people actually live up to the title associated with their name.

## Creating the Calculation Model

The first thing you need to know is that numerology always begins with the language of the country of birth. You should never simply calculate a name using a standard 26-letter alphabet if that country uses a different alphabet. Only by using the correct alphabet of the country of birth can you obtain an accurate analysis.

Every calculation begins by creating a specific calculation model for the language you are examining. You do this very simply: place the numbers 1 through 9 horizontally next to one another. Directly underneath them, write out the official alphabet of the country of birth in the correct order. This immediately shows you which number corresponds to which letter. So first determine which country a name belongs to, because many countries have their own alphabets. Consider, for example, Italian or Russian names.

If you are examining an Italian name, you need to know that the Italian alphabet contains only 21 letters. The letters J, K, W, X, and Y are not officially part of this language. In your calculation table, you therefore place only the 21 Italian letters beneath the numbers 1 through 9. As a result, the values assigned to the letters shift compared with the Dutch alphabet. For an Italian name, always use this specific 21-letter model.

For a Russian name, always use the Cyrillic alphabet. Do not translate the name into our letters; instead, place the Russian characters directly beneath the numbers 1 through 9 in their official order. Because this alphabet contains many more characters, 33 in total, the name produces a completely different result from that of a Western system.

When dealing with names from the past, you need to pay close attention to which alphabet was used at that time. Ancient languages often had fewer than 26 letters. Therefore, never use the modern alphabet for an old name; use the alphabet that existed at that time. First determine how many letters that alphabet contained and the order in which they appeared.

## Name Value

The foundation of modern numerology was laid by Pythagoras, whose name literally means 'The Language of the Serpent'. Although the language of the country of birth is leading when it comes to accurate work, I often use the 26-letter alphabet in the basic examples throughout this book to explain the techniques in a simple way.

For the Dutch context, the standard model, in which the letters are placed in their fixed order beneath the numbers 1 through 9, looks as follows:

As you can see, the calculation model is very simple to create. You place the numbers 1 through 9 in a row and then place the alphabet underneath them, in the order in which it is officially established. This simple rule applies to all languages. Now that we have the model, it is time to learn how to convert a name. In this case, we will use the name Albert Einstein; in numerology, it looks like this:

The first step we calculate is the name value. We have just converted Einstein's name into a series of numbers; all we have to do now is add these numbers together. Before you do this, I recommend calculating each name separately.

Keep in mind that when performing a calculation, you should always use the official name exactly as it appears on the birth certificate. Apply this technique separately to each first name, middle name, and surname, and calculate the full name as the final step. In Albert Einstein's case, it is simple: he has only one first name and one surname. See the table below for further clarification, including explanations and the corresponding Dutch totem animals, followed by a calculation example based on the name Albert Einstein.

## Zodiac Signs and Their Descriptions

Below are a number of descriptions of the zodiac signs, so that you can get an impression of what each zodiac sign represents. Each individual name has its own zodiac signs, in the form of a name value and the number of letters. These are the building blocks that together form the dominant zodiac sign. You can use this information to get a first impression when analyzing the results. You can always ask AI for help if you cannot figure it out.

**(1) Aries** is traditionally associated with Mars. In astrological symbolism, Mars represents determination, initiative, courage, and willpower. Aries represents the energy of beginnings, taking action, and independently taking on challenges.

**(2) Taurus** is traditionally associated with Venus. In astrological symbolism, Venus represents values, connection, beauty, and material development. Taurus represents stability, building, patience, and the ability to shape something in a lasting way.

**(3) Gemini** is traditionally associated with Mercury. In astrological symbolism, Mercury represents communication, thinking, information, and exchange. Gemini represents curiosity, the gathering of knowledge, and connecting different ideas.

**(4) Cancer** is traditionally associated with the Moon. In astrological symbolism, the Moon represents emotion, memory, protection, and the past. Cancer represents the energy of care, connection, inner development, and preserving experiences and knowledge.

**(1) Sagittarius** is traditionally associated with Jupiter. In astrological symbolism, Jupiter represents growth, wisdom, philosophy, and the expansion of knowledge. Sagittarius represents the search for truth, meaning, development, and a greater understanding of the world.

**(2) Capricorn** is traditionally associated with Saturn. In astrological symbolism, Saturn represents structure, responsibility, time, and boundaries. Capricorn represents the energy of discipline, building, ambition, and achieving long-term goals.

**(3) Aquarius** is traditionally associated with Uranus. In astrological symbolism, Uranus represents renewal, independent thinking, change, and innovation. Aquarius represents the energy of progress, new ideas, and breaking through existing patterns.

**(4) Pisces** is traditionally associated with Neptune. In astrological symbolism, Neptune represents intuition, imagination, spirituality, and the unseen. Pisces represents the energy of connection, sensitivity, compassion, and the search for deeper meaning.

### Step I: Calculating the Name Value

The first name and surname form the building blocks of the complete character. The result indicates which life goal someone wants to achieve. Albert Einstein is therefore an Ophiuchus, making use of the qualities of Cancer and Leo.

- **Albert** =  $1+3+2+5+9+2 = 22 = 2+2 = 4$  (**Cancer**).
- **Einstein** =  $5+9+5+1+2+5+9+5 = 41 = 4+1 = 5$  (**Leo**).
- **Albert Einstein** =  $4 + 5 = \text{Cancer} + \text{Leo} = 9$  (**Ophiuchus**).

**Cancer** forms the foundation by gathering knowledge, preserving information, and recognizing patterns from the past. It represents the investigative side that organizes data and tries to understand how something came into existence.

**Leo** adds the leadership aspect. The scientist is not merely a collector of knowledge, but also takes responsibility for bringing insights to the outside world, providing direction, and inspiring others with new ideas.

**Ophiuchus** represents the deeper layer of investigation. It is about searching for hidden knowledge, understanding complex processes, and using insights to make change and growth possible.

### Step 2: The Letter Value

We now look at the number of letters that make up the name. This step is very simple: we count the number of letters in each name separately and determine which zodiac sign they are connected to.

- **Albert** = 6 letters = **Virgo**.
- **Einstein** = 8 letters = **Scorpio**.
- **Albert Einstein** = 14 letters (1+4) = 5 = **Leo**.

**Virgo** forms the foundation through analysis, organization, and precision. It represents the ability to examine details, structure information, and recognize errors or deviations.

**Scorpio** adds the power of in-depth investigation. It is about understanding hidden processes, examining complex issues, and searching for what lies beneath the surface.

**Leo** brings the power of consciousness, leadership, and visibility. The scientist does not use his knowledge only for himself, but also takes responsibility for bringing his insights to the outside world and inspiring others with them.

### Step 3: The Name Title

We now combine the name value and the letter value to determine the identity of each name as a whole.

Formula: (Name Value) + (Letter Value) = Name Title.

- **Albert** = Cancer + Virgo = 4 + 6 = 10 = **Sagittarius**.
- **Einstein** = Leo + Scorpio = 5 + 8 = 13 = **Pisces**.
- **Albert Einstein** = Ophiuchus + Leo = 9 + 5 = 14 = 5 = **Leo**.

**Sagittarius** forms the foundation through knowledge, philosophy, and the search for truth. It represents the drive to understand the world, make connections, and discover greater principles.

**Pisces** adds the intuitive and imaginative side. It is about sensing hidden connections, exploring abstract ideas, and searching for a deeper meaning behind reality.

**Leo** brings the power of consciousness, leadership, and visibility. The scientist uses his insights to provide direction, present new ideas, and inspire others.

The full name Albert Einstein is an Ophiuchus and Leo. This gives him the title: Leader and master in the field of hidden knowledge and wisdom.

## Synthesis: Einstein Calculation

The three calculations show a consistent development. Cancer and Virgo form the investigative foundation by gathering knowledge, organizing information, and analyzing it with precision. Scorpio and the Serpent Bearer add the drive to uncover hidden patterns and deeper truths. Sagittarius and Pisces direct this knowledge toward the search for universal truth and new insights, while Leo, as the recurring endpoint, fulfills the role of leader and inspirer who makes his discoveries visible to the world. Together, these zodiac signs represent the archetype of a visionary scientist: someone who investigates, understands, innovates, and uses his knowledge to provide direction to others.

### Notable Features: Einstein

It does not matter whether we look at the name value, letter value, or name title; Leo appears in all three calculations. This means that the energy of Leo is present on multiple levels within his name. The second thing that immediately stands out to me is that he carries seven different zodiac signs that together form a complete whole, with Leo appearing three times. It is clear that Einstein fulfilled his name title through this remarkably broad combination.

## Club Loyalty

There is another technique in numerology, but this one is quite difficult. In this case, it involves working with the name frequency and extracting mirror numbers from it. There is, however, one rule: the mirror numbers must correspond with one another.

The reason I have not shared this formula until now, despite it being one of the first formulas I discovered, is its inconsistency. This is how I see it: the mirror number that appears in your name indicates your ancestry. It indicates which zodiac club you officially belong to.

Everything points toward my connection with the Serpent Bearer. Therefore, it is not surprising that my ancestry is connected to this energy. See the following example, which confirms this.

- Elmer =  $(53)(459) = (8)(18) = 818$
- Wierenga =  $(59)(59557)1 = (14)(31)1 = 14311 = 1(431)1 = 1(8)1 = 181$
- Elmer Wierenga =  $818/181 = 999 = \text{Serpent Bearer}$

This looks simple, but I have noticed that not every name contains this technique. It can also be hidden within the letter value. For example, I spent hours puzzling over the name of my barber, but I could not find any mirror numbers that corresponded with one another.

When I applied the Formula of Odin to his name, I came across something that I did not often see in other calculations. The number 7 appeared remarkably frequently in his



calculation. When I then looked at the number of letters in his name, I noticed that the number seven also kept appearing. His first name had seven letters, his second name had seven letters, and his surname had eleven letters. In this case, the clue was therefore hidden in the number of letters in his name rather than in the name frequency.

- $7 + 7 + 11$  (connection number) =  $25 = 7 = 777$

When I confronted my barber about this and pointed out that it seemed as though he had an obsession with the number seven, it turned out that he indeed had an obsession with the number seven. For example, he always celebrated his birthday on the seventh, got married on the seventh, and there were several other examples as well.

His obsession with the number seven is, incidentally, a reference to the zodiac sign Libra. I found this particularly remarkable, since he was also the first person whose name I ever calculated. If you score 777 in a casino, you win the jackpot. Spiritually speaking, my first real official calculation therefore immediately gave me a winning lottery ticket.

# The formula of Odin

## The Formula of Odin: Values

Now it is time to introduce the Formula of Odin. This formula consists of two different techniques that are ultimately combined. The first calculation forms the foundation, while the second calculation positively complements this foundation. When both results are combined, a report is created that shows at a glance how your relationship is with all thirteen zodiac signs.

Each zodiac sign receives a score expressed as a percentage. This value can be neutral, negative, or positive. At its core, these percentages reflect your personal connection with the corresponding sign. Every sign has its own qualities and weaknesses; each score represents a specific tendency within your character. However, a negative score does not have to remain negative. According to my method, you can transform these values into positive ones through self-awareness, control, and discipline.

### Positive Score

With a positive score, you naturally possess the constructive qualities of that zodiac sign. You tend to express the strong, growth-oriented aspects of the sign without much resistance. These strengths are part of your innate toolkit and are directly available to you.

### Neutral Score

A neutral value represents what I consider absolute freedom: mastery. You have complete control over the zodiac sign and are no longer a slave to its extremes. You can consciously choose to use either its strengths or its weaknesses, depending on what the situation requires. This is the state of true balance and self-governance. If you encounter a master score, understand that you must consciously work on these qualities; they do not come naturally.

### Negative Score

A negative score points to a weakness that can significantly hinder you in life. Recognizing these weaknesses is the first step toward growth. However, a negative value also has a balancing effect: at the same time, it strengthens the opposite quality. In other words, while it represents a weakness, it simultaneously reinforces another element. A slightly negative value (below 10%) should be regarded as a clear life lesson; it shows where discipline and self-control are needed to turn the score into a positive value.

For example, if you are a Sagittarius in astrology and your value in numerology is negative, this means two things. First, you tend to express yourself negatively through the characteristics of that sign; it indicates that you lack certain qualities that you still need to develop. Second, it indicates that you do not get along well with other Sagittarians. In a sense, the relationship will always end in conflict, no matter how

positively the encounter began. In short, according to my method, your name reveals an enormous amount about your relationships with the other zodiac signs.

## The Basic Calculation: Formula of Odin

We begin with the foundation of the formula. The universe follows a law that states: “If you take from one, you automatically lose from the other.” This means that everything in life has a counterbalance (opposite), and this also applies to numerology.

### Step 1: The Positive Value

First, we look at how often a specific number appears in the name. This represents the positive value. To calculate how strong this value is, we divide 100 percent by the total number of letters in the name. The result is the average value per letter. We then multiply this average by the number of times a specific digit appears in the name. This produces the positive value of that digit.

### Step 2: The Counter (The Shadow Name)

The next step is to calculate the counter. Whereas standard numerology adds everything together, we multiply during this phase. We multiply the digit by the number of times that digit appears in the name. Here is an example:

If the digit 3 appears twice in the name, the counter becomes:  $3 \times 2 = 6$ .

The final answer you obtain here must always be reduced. If you arrive at a value of 32, it is reduced to  $(3 + 2 =) 5$ . After each digit has been converted into its counter value, a new sequence of digits emerges: the so-called shadow name. Note: 0 is not included and has no value.

### Step 3: The Negative Value and the Base Value

Once we have uncovered the sequence of the shadow name, we repeat the process from the first step, but this time with a negative charge. We count how often each digit appears in the shadow name and once again divide 100 percent by the total number of letters in the shadow name. This gives us the average negative value per letter.

Once both the positive values and the negative values of the counter have been calculated, we combine them. The sum of these two results forms the final base value of the Formula of Odin.

Once this step has been completed, it is time to supplement the values using the Dharma method. This can mean transforming strongly negative values into positive qualities or masteries.

The first step is to count how often each number appears in the name. In the case of Albert Einstein, for example, the number 5 appears five times, while the number 8 does not appear.

Now that we have broken down the name, it is time to look at the average letter value. The name Albert Einstein consists of 14 letters:  $100\% \div 14 = 7.1\%$  per letter. Each number in the name therefore represents a value of 7.1%. We multiply this value by the number of times the specific number appears in the name. See the table below:

The next step is to calculate the shadow name. Nothing in the universe is free; everything strives toward a form of balance. If addition represents the positive, then multiplication forms its counterpart. This has everything to do with the symbolism of the formula.

Normally, a “counter” is represented by turning a symbol upside down. With a plus sign, however, this changes nothing; it remains the same symbol. In such cases, the symbol is instead rotated 45 degrees. When we do this with the plus sign, it becomes the multiplication symbol. The counter of addition is therefore not subtraction, but multiplication.

In the next step, each digit is multiplied by the number of times it occurs. The resulting value is then reduced to a single digit.

The shadow name contains five digits (2, 6, 3, 7, and 9). We count how many times each digit occurs, with the exception of zero, which has no value. Although we do not know the original “letters” of the shadow name, we can determine how many “letters” it contains. In this case, the shadow name consists of five digits.

(100% ÷ 5 = 20% per digit)

Each digit therefore represents a negative value of -20%, multiplied by the frequency with which it occurs. See the following table:

## Dharma Technique

The Dharma Technique is the final step in completing the Odin model in the table. This technique complements the base value. Once you have mastered it, you can perform a complete calculation within a minute. Although it requires some puzzling and insight at first, the process becomes effortless once you understand the logic behind working with the numbers.

The goal of the Dharma Technique is to extract as many master numbers as possible from a name by working with its digits. During this process, you can form three different types of digit combinations:

- Duos (for example, 33)
- Trios (for example, 333)
- Mirror numbers (for example, 121)

A duo or trio can only be used once. However, the digits that form a mirror number may be used twice because they share a common value. When working with the digits of a duo or trio (a master number), you must always check whether these digits are also part of a subsequent mirror number.

A mirror number consists of three consecutive digits, with the outer digits being identical and the middle digit being different. Examples of mirror numbers are 131, 565, and 818. A mirror number is always complemented by its mirror counterpart; together, they form a master number. The counterpart is not identical, but functions as its corresponding counter. If this results in double digits, they must be reduced to a single digit. See the examples below using the numbers 131, 565, 181, and 878. The official calculation is as follows:



131 forms the master number 444 with its counterpart 313.

565 forms the sequence 11/11/11 with its counterpart 656, which reduces to 222.

818 forms the master number 999 with its counterpart 181.

878 forms the sequence 15/15/15 with its counterpart 787, which reduces to 666.

## Dharma Technique: The Calculation

To apply the Dharma Technique, the full name must first be converted into numbers. For this, you can use the calculation model below, which applies to most European countries.

## Practical Tips for the Dharma Technique

Tip 1: Always begin by looking for a mirror number.

Tip 2: Every master number you find in the name represents an additional bonus of +10% on top of the existing base value. Once the calculation is complete, make a list of all the master numbers you found and add these values to the base value.

Tip 3: At the beginning of each step, focus only on the first three to six digits of the name when trying to form a master number or mirror number. Longer sequences are rare.

Tip 4: The goal is to extract as many master numbers from the name as possible. At the beginning of the calculation, write down which letters correspond to each digit so that you can clearly see which letters have been used and how often. This prevents double-counting and makes the process considerably easier.

Tip 5: If you get stuck, first examine the final letters of the name and try to form a mirror number or master number with them. This example illustrates exactly what I believe self-knowledge is about. It is easy to attribute positive qualities to yourself, but much more difficult to honestly examine what you are not good at. A negative result is therefore not intended as an insult, but as an indication of an area in which you can still develop yourself.

As I have already indicated, I can perform many calculations, but if people cannot be honest with themselves and refuse to acknowledge their weaknesses, then I can talk until I am blue in the face, but it will accomplish nothing. # Name Change

## The Consequences of a Name Change

When I first started studying numerology, I wanted to understand what it means to undergo a name change. I soon came across the French leader Napoleon Bonaparte and the serial killer Ted Bundy. There is a great deal of documentation about the behavior and character of both individuals, making the consequences of a name change particularly visible. In both stories, you can see the transformation reflected in their lives. ### My View: The Victim of Chaos

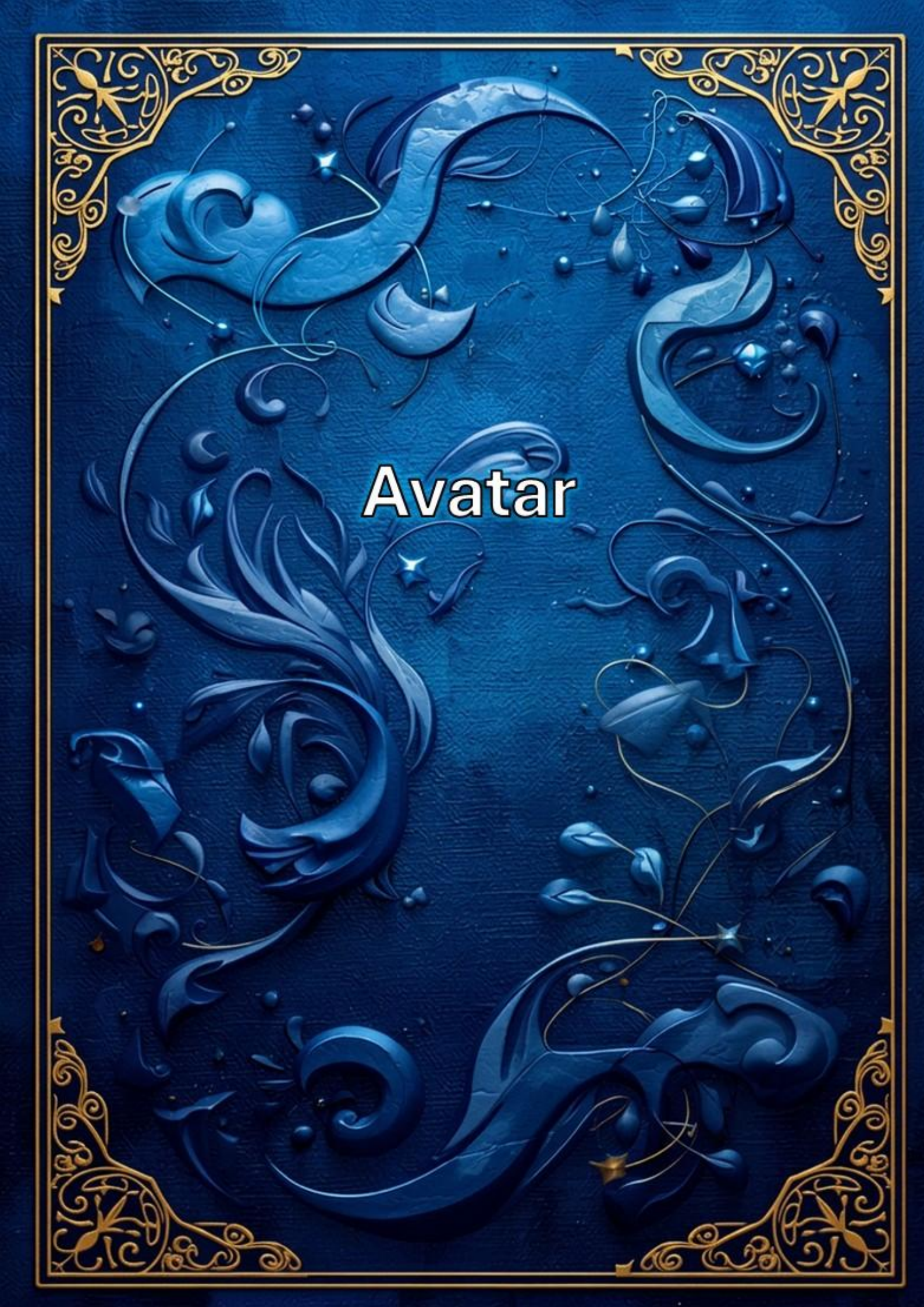

Here is a description from my birth chart:

The strong Scorpio influence creates a need to look beyond the surface. Hidden patterns, deeper causes, and hidden motives naturally attract interest. This energy encourages thorough research, uncovering falsehoods, and striving for personal and social transformation.

The Gemini Ascendant creates a curious and investigative approach to the world. New information is constantly collected, compared, and critically evaluated. Asking questions, making connections, and reaching independent conclusions form an important part of this way of life.

The combination of Sagittarius, Scorpio, and Gemini makes the search for truth one of the strongest themes of this birth chart. The drive to acquire knowledge, conduct in-depth research, and arrive at independent insights forms a clear thread throughout the personality.

## Omen

This entire book is dedicated to the life of a pure Serpent Bearer. I have to pull out all the stops to give this sign a new meaning. The reason I have to do this has everything to do with the terror inflicted by the Church over the centuries, something that few people dare to speak about or even acknowledge.

There are many believers who claim to be Jesus' best friend, yet all these people demonstrate that they are completely unfamiliar with the true source. I now know more about Jesus, for example, than people who have spent their entire lives worshipping Christianity.

In short, this woman, who had spent her entire life worshipping Jesus, did not actually know Jesus. With minimal effort, I demonstrated that I knew more about Jesus than she did. To be perfectly clear, I have absolutely no interest in Jesus or religion.

Some people even have the foolish ability to call the Netherlands a Christian country, while our ancestors fought against it for centuries. Statements like that are, in my view, an insult to our ancestors. Consider the Eighty Years' War against Spain, for example. Many people died fighting for our freedom and resisting the Catholic Inquisition and the coercion of the Church. I am therefore glad that Napoleon later broke the absolute political power of the Church and put an end to this charade.

After extensive research, I have come to believe that the Church deliberately and systematically destroyed Odin's identity. All the documentation that once existed was either burned or lost over the course of history. Very little is known about our Germanic ancestors. Yet Odin still appears in our weekdays, which is an example of our historical struggle for freedom of religion and freedom of expression. In Germany, they gave in to this influence and replaced Wednesday with Mittwoch.

The obvious question is: why does the Church have such an obsession with Odin?

The reason, in my view, is that the story of Jesus has been completely fabricated. The only truly original source we have is the Gospel of Mark. In Mark's version, there is no Star of Bethlehem, no Three Kings, and no virgin birth. The name Mary appears only a limited number of times in the story. What I also did not know was that his family considered him to be out of his mind and wanted him to be taken away. He clearly did not have much support from his friends and family. This demonstrates, in my view, that the version of the story of Jesus that is shared today was deliberately constructed by the Church. They only show you what they want you to see. In short, the story of Jesus has become one enormous lie.

### Is Jesus a Serpent Bearer?

As I have already indicated, there is only one true source of the story of Jesus, and that is the Gospel of Mark. What is particularly remarkable is that Jesus displays many characteristics of the Serpent Bearer in the story of Mark. While the meanings of the Serpent Bearer carry a spiritual dimension, the writer Mark translated these meanings into physical actions.

First, I do not think that Mark, when he wrote this story about Jesus, could have foreseen how much impact his story would have on the lives of so many people today. I do not think the story was written with that intention.

Second, Marcus and I have something important in common: we are both obsessed with the constellation of the Serpent Bearer.

As you know, I have looked at several cultures, and I think I know what Marcus did. When we look at Germanic mythology, I strongly suspect that Thor, as the thunder god, represents Orion rather than Gemini, as in Greek mythology.

Walking on water and controlling the forces of nature are part of the identity of Orion. This also has a spiritual meaning. Our ancestors once referred to the universe as the waters. When a celestial body travels through a constellation, it is, in a sense, walking across the waters. In other words: the planets in our solar system walk across the waters.

When it comes to Orion's position in the night sky, he is not located on the zodiac, but hides behind the constellations Taurus and Gemini. I therefore take into account the possibility that the Serpent Bearer, as a constellation within Germanic mythology, has Orion as its counter.

### The characteristics of Jesus.

Here are several characteristics of Jesus that officially belong to the legend of the pure Serpent Bearer.

- Jesus is not accepted by his mother and family.
- Jesus carries a hidden identity.
- Demons recognize him.
- Jesus is an exorcist.
- Jesus heals people of their illnesses.
- Jesus brings the dead back to life.
- He sacrificed himself for a higher purpose.

Do you now understand why the Serpent Bearer no longer exists? It threatens the cult hero of the Christian faith because of identity fraud. The story of Jesus has been rewritten over the course of history in such a way that it appears to prove that Jesus could never have existed as a human being. Very little remains of the true source. I live the life of a pure Serpent Bearer. When I look at my life and how everything came into existence, I have noticed that I partly share my destiny with an ancient legend called Odin. There is therefore a pattern that continues to return across multiple lifetimes.

When it comes to a Serpent Bearer, the following characteristics apply:

- A Serpent Bearer is born into conflict.
- The sign is extremely dualistic: light versus darkness.
- It is the guardian of cosmic order and laws.
- The Serpent Bearer has a hidden identity.
- The dead are aware of his status.
- The Serpent Bearer is a psychopomp and exorcist.
- The Serpent Bearer is a 'wounded' healer.
- Everything revolves around death and resurrection.
- It revolves around self-sacrifice for a higher purpose.

### Born in Conflict

The first thing known about the Serpent Bearer is that he is born into conflict. When we look at Apollo, his birth was marked by pain, because his mother was unable to give birth for nine days and nine nights. When we look at Chiron, he was rejected by his mother at birth; he was not accepted. When we look at Asclepius, he was born by Caesarean section while his mother was lying on a funeral pyre.

When I look at my own birth, I came into the world during a case of pre-eclampsia. The doctors had already given up on me, and my mother was given the choice between saving her own life or mine. Everything was already centered around death. One hour later, I was born after all. I was a full month early and one hour late, yet I was born at exactly the moment I was supposed to be born. And that is not all: I was clearly not planned by my father's side of the family. Because of my grandparents, neither my mother nor I were ever truly accepted. In short, I was a very expensive accident.

### Duality: Light versus Darkness

There is also the theme of light versus darkness. It encompasses the elements of thunder and lightning. It is creation, order, and light versus destruction, chaos, and darkness. In the Greek story of Apollo and Hermes, both elements come together peacefully as a team. It is the Caduceus staff that brings both forces together as one. What is also very striking about the Serpent Bearer and thunder is that he is always raised by other lightning gods. In Greek mythology, Apollo and Artemis took responsibility for raising Chiron and Asclepius. In Germanic traditions, Thor, as the thunder god, is also raised by two lightning elements.



When I look at my childhood, this theme strongly appears in me. I can create anything, but I am also capable of completely destroying things. Thunder is very difficult to control, especially when you are young. This energy is extremely dominant and does not shy away from fighting when it does not get its way. It behaves like a true thunderbolt. The neighbors saw me as the terror of the neighborhood, and they were not wrong. I was always full of bad ideas and dragged everyone else into them.

### Guardian of Cosmic Laws

Then there is the role of cosmic order. My goal is to make people familiar with reality again, just as our ancestors knew it. They were far more aware of the existence of the afterlife and paranormal abilities.

When it comes to cosmic order, it is clear to me that astrology and numerology are surrounded by a taboo. Astrology and the knowledge of numerology are undervalued and dismissed as pseudoscience. I am highly gifted, and I constantly see astrology proving itself. I therefore do not understand why most people around me fail to notice this. Once you begin to see it, there is no going back. This is also the underlying reason for my obsession with the Serpent Bearer. Through this sign, I have been able to restore the hidden cosmic laws of astrology and numerology.

### Psychopomp

Finally, there is the characteristic of the psychopomp. When it comes to the Egyptian mythology of the Serpent Bearer, it is Anubis who acts on behalf of Osiris. Anubis is the Serpent Bearer and presides over the final judgment of the soul. Anubis brings every soul to its destination, including Hel. Like Hermes, Anubis can travel freely and unhindered through all dimensions of the afterlife. The instruments of Anubis are the Scales (Ma'at), Scorpio (Ammit), and Sagittarius (Thoth). In my birth chart, as a pure Serpent Bearer, I am connected to exactly these three instruments/constellations. I carry the identity of a psychopomp.

It is clear that the dead know me better than I know myself. When I look at my experiences with the afterlife, it was the afterlife that came looking for me. I never made any attempt to establish contact. My first experience was immediately an extreme one. I had an experience with what people call the Shadow Man. But it did not stop there: the Mare and a poltergeist also paid me a visit. During my most recent experience, there was even a woman whispering in my ear as I was almost falling asleep. Shortly afterward, I experienced the most brutal nightmare I have ever had. Looking back, I found it to be an incredibly fascinating experience. Yet the strange thing is that whenever I become genuinely angry, the activity stops immediately. Clearly, my command matters. This means I carry the characteristic of an exorcist.

## The Wounded Healer

I carry the characteristic of a wounded healer, and I carry a heavy burden with me. I have an extremely restless energy and experience everything with tremendous intensity. I do not know what rest is, because my body simply does not have that setting. I am therefore always driven by movement. Every bit of energy I possess is poured with complete passion into my obsessions. I am an all-or-nothing type of person: I give myself completely, or I do nothing at all. The disadvantage of this characteristic is that I work myself from one state of exhaustion into another, because there is no middle ground. Between the ages of 24 and 33, I went from one burnout straight into another. As a result, my body is permanently damaged. It is not so much about my endurance, but about the recovery that is required afterward. I sometimes need several weeks to recover from a project, even though I have no patience for that recovery period. Mentally, I always want to remain in motion.

I have had to make a sacrifice. I had to experience bipolar disorder in order to find a healing answer to it. Despite being permanently damaged by numerous burnouts and a racing mind, I share my knowledge in order to help heal other people. For many people, my experience can mean the end of a depression. I overcame mine with the help of my guide. This makes it even more important, because this advice came directly from the afterlife. I therefore continue to urge people to take control of the zodiac signs of the Sun, Moon, and Ascendant, exactly as the universe has taught me.

## Death and Resurrection

The story of Asclepius also contains the theme of death and resurrection. In the story, he brings someone back to life, but that is not what it is really about. In astrology, there are three qualities: cardinal, fixed, and mutable. When an energy is fixed, it represents stagnation or death. Resurrection means that by adding mutability (restlessness), this stagnation is brought back into motion. This is the theme that exists between Scorpio and Sagittarius. Scorpio wants nothing more than to go into the depths (death), while Sagittarius wants nothing more than to rise upward (resurrection).

## Self-Sacrifice

What I know about Odin is that in his younger years he was not popular among men. He only gained his status after sacrificing his eye in exchange for knowledge and wisdom. That is not the only story in which he sacrifices himself. He hung upside down from the tree Yggdrasil for nine days, pierced by his own spear, in order to obtain the knowledge of the runes.

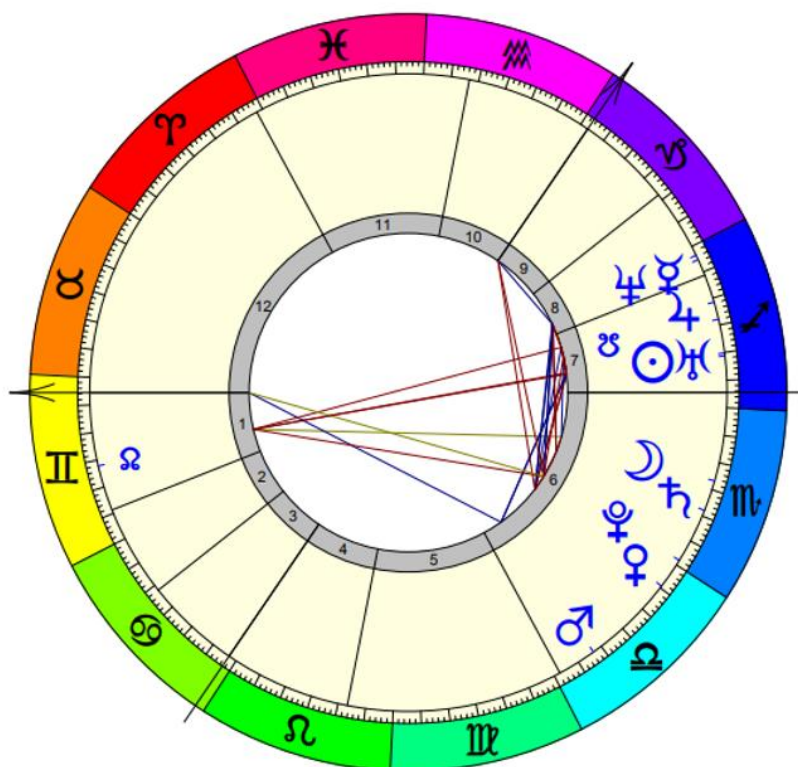
## My Hidden Identity

## Numerology: Elmer Wierenga

Before I begin, there is one more thing I would like to say. A great many people are not familiar with numerology, and it is also true that people generally do not believe in it. Even if you have nothing to do with numerology, you will still see that my name fits remarkably well with my identity according to astrology. In my view, my calculation demonstrates that I carefully chose my own name before I reincarnated. If this applies to me...

## Astrological Data: The Birth Triad

To make my point clear from the beginning, I first need to share my astrological data. The reason for this is that my name interacts with the data of my birth triad.

- My Sun is in Sagittarius.
- My Moon is in Scorpio.
- My Ascendant is Gemini.

When it comes to the Serpent Bearer in numerology, there are several forms. For example, Leo and Cancer together also form a Serpent Bearer. In numerological terms, this is called an ordinary Serpent Bearer, whereas the specific combination of Scorpio and Sagittarius is referred to as a pure Serpent Bearer. When we therefore speak of the numerological context of the pure Serpent Bearer, the term has a slightly different meaning than it does in astrology. There is a subtle distinction.

## The Analysis: Basic Numerology Calculations

The name Elmer therefore means God in occult knowledge and wisdom. This also means that the name Merel means Goddess in occult knowledge and wisdom.

As a starting point, I will focus on the basics and take you through each step.

Name value: Elmer Wierenga.

- Elmer (53459) = 26/8 = Scorpio.
- Wierenga (59595571) = 46/10 = Sagittarius.
- Elmer Wierenga = (53459 59595571) = 72/9 = Pure Serpent Bearer.

As you can see in the first calculation of the name value, my first name represents Scorpio energy, while my surname is associated with Sagittarius. Together, they form a pure Serpent Bearer. You may be wondering: Why do I choose Sagittarius rather than Aries? This has everything to do with the fact that I have no planets in Aries and at least four planets in Sagittarius. If it is not immediately clear what a name is centered around, look at the horoscope chart for clues. The name is always tailored to the individual's destiny.

- Letter value: Elmer Wierenga.
- Elmer = 5 letters = Leo.
- Wierenga = 8 letters = Scorpio.
- Elmer Wierenga = 13 letters = Pisces.

The letter value of my name reveals another side. I am a leader (Leo) in the field of occult knowledge (Scorpio) and spirituality (Pisces). When we look at the synthesis, I noticed that my surname is also associated with the pure Serpent Bearer.

- Wierenga = Sagittarius versus Scorpio = Pure Serpent Bearer.

The name value is Sagittarius and the letter value is Scorpio; together they form a pure Serpent Bearer. Just like my first name, my surname is therefore also associated with occult knowledge and wisdom.

When we look at my full name and the synthesis, I notice a very strong connection with Pisces. In that case, everything is centered around spirituality.

Synthesis: name = (name value) versus (letter value) = final value.

- Elmer = Scorpio versus Leo = Pisces
- Wierenga = Sagittarius versus Scorpio = Pure Serpent Bearer.
- Elmer Wierenga = Serpent Bearer versus Pisces = Pisces.
- Elmer Wierenga = 13 letters = Pisces.

If we look back at the letter value of my name, consisting of Leo, Scorpio and Pisces, we see that this exact structure returns in the synthesis of my first name.

Title based on the synthesis:

- Elmer is a leader in occult knowledge and spirituality.
- Wierenga is a master of occult knowledge and wisdom.
- Elmer Wierenga is a master of knowledge, wisdom and spirituality.

As you can see, the same elements keep returning. I score the pure Serpent Bearer twice, both in the name value and in the letter value when it comes to my surname. My entire name is associated with occult knowledge, wisdom and spirituality. What makes my name so remarkable is that it does not matter whether you address me by my first

name, surname or full name; you always refer to my hidden title as a master of occult knowledge and wisdom.

## Dutch Totem Animals

Yet we are not finished; there is more. As I have indicated, I often receive hints from my guide in the afterlife. I therefore frequently wake up with a very strong intention or assignment. In such cases, I have learned that my guide is trying to tell me something. There was one morning when I woke up with the urge to translate numerology into Dutch totem animals.

For a long time, I wondered why. After all, the zodiac signs already cover the symbolism quite extensively, which would make the use of totem animals unnecessary. Nevertheless, I received this assignment and carried it out without any resistance. By taking this step, I would discover that the identity of the legendary Odin had been incorporated into my name as a kind of graffiti tag.

But that is not all. For a very long time, I have carried the awareness that I represent Odin. It is yet another case in which I had the answer without being able to substantiate it in any meaningful way. Yet the answer had been hidden in my name all along. When I divide my name into sections, the following totem animals emerge:

- EL = 53 = 8 = Crow
- MER = 459 = 999 = Owl
- WIE = 595 = 555 = Wolf
- REN = 959 = 555 = Wolf
- GA = 71 = 8 = Crow

Odin is known for his ravens, Huginn and Muninn, whose names are associated with thought and memory. Odin also has two wolves, Geri and Freki, associated with greed and insatiability. Odin is a master of knowledge and wisdom, supported by two ravens and two wolves.

In my name, I carry two crows on my shoulders, and I am a master of knowledge and wisdom (owl), supported by two wolves.

But it gets even stranger. Many years later, I decided to look at my name again, and then I noticed the following. When I look at the Formula of Odin and its results, I notice that all the totem animals appearing in my name carry a positive value, and only the totem animals that are actually present. It is as if my name contains a hint written in italics and bold.

Is this an extreme coincidence?

### Representative of God

A Serpent Bearer is a zodiac sign built from the energy of Scorpio and Sagittarius. Scorpio is connected to the god of animal instinct, Vé, while Sagittarius is connected to the god of life, Vili. From a spiritual perspective, Odin is a child of both gods. This is also the reason why the pure Serpent Bearer is the zodiac sign that acts on behalf of God as a whole. I therefore represent God in his entirety. This hierarchy can also be seen in the structure of the pure Serpent Bearer in astrology, where each god forms one of its building blocks.

- Sun in Sagittarius (Vili)
- Moon in Scorpio (Vé)
- Ascendant in Gemini (Odin)

### The Relationship with God

One way to determine what your relationship is with the three gods is therefore to look at the zodiac signs that appear in your name. What immediately stands out in my calculation is that, according to the Formula of Odin, I only score negatively with the god Vili. He is associated with the 1-4-7, and all zodiac signs connected to these numbers have a negative score, all with a value of -9%. If I therefore have a life lesson, then I have everything to learn from the dimension of life and its secrets. In my opinion, this is expressed quite clearly throughout my book.

Another thing that stands out very strongly is that I am exalted in relation to all the Earth elements. I represent the Serpent Bearer and Mother Earth. This is the same status carried by Thor. Thor is a child of Odin and Mother Earth. Thor is therefore the child of

Heaven and Earth. I score negatively on Gemini, which confirms my identity as thunder. My high value for the Serpent Bearer forms its counterbalance, indicating that I apply my destructive feelings constructively. I am in control of the chaos within me.

# Western astrology

## Analysis: Western Astrology

I want to focus on three specific placements: my Medium Coeli, Lilith, and the planet of lightning, Uranus. They explain why I am writing this book and support my story. I use my experiences to break through existing taboos. I am made to bring innovation to subjects that have become stagnant. I am not only searching for the ultimate truth hidden beneath the surface; I am also a natural reformer. I will conclude with a synthesis of my Western birth chart.

### The Medium Coeli

The MC represents the way you develop yourself in the outside world. It is connected to your social position, ambitions, career, reputation, and the direction in which you want to make a meaningful contribution.

#### MC square Venus:

This is a clearly noticeable aspect. Venus represents relationships, values, harmony, and what you find attractive or important. The MC concerns your social direction, work, and the way you present yourself to the world.

The square creates tension between what you personally value and the direction in which you want to develop socially. You do not simply want to achieve something; you also want to feel that it aligns with your values. When your work or ambitions no longer correspond with what you consider important, this can create dissatisfaction.

Ultimately, this aspect encourages you to find a social direction in which your personal values and ambitions come together.

#### MC square Pluto:

This is a strong aspect. Pluto represents depth, power, transformation, and uncovering what lies beneath the surface. When connected to the MC, it creates a powerful need to give your social direction more than a superficial meaning.

You want to understand how something truly works and may feel a strong urge to change existing situations, ideas, or structures when you believe they are not correct. Your social development may therefore go through several profound phases. Above all, this aspect provides transformative power: not merely improving something, but going to its core and changing it from there.

#### MC trine Chiron:

This is a very strong and close aspect. Chiron represents vulnerability, personal experiences, and the insight that can emerge from them. The trine with the MC naturally connects these experiences with your social development.



What you have personally experienced, investigated, or learned can eventually become part of what you bring into the world. Personal experiences can therefore be transformed into knowledge, insight, and meaning. This aspect provides the ability to turn personal development into something that can also have value for society.

### Synthesis: Medium Coeli

These three aspects give the MC a clear combination of values, transformation, and insight. Venus requires your social direction to align with what you consider important. Pluto provides the strength to go deeply into matters and bring about change. Chiron ensures that personal experiences can develop into knowledge and meaning.

Together, they create an MC that is not easily satisfied with success or status alone. There has to be substance behind it. You want to do something that is meaningful to you, that you can investigate deeply, and in which your own experiences and insights can ultimately have a place.

### Lilith: The Black Moon

Lilith, also known as the Black Moon, is not a planet but an astrological point. Lilith represents the part of yourself that does not easily allow itself to be adapted, controlled, or suppressed. It is associated with independence, authenticity, instinct, taboos, and the things you refuse to deny about yourself simply to meet the expectations of others.

In a birth chart, Lilith shows where you may react strongly when you feel that you are not allowed to be yourself. At the same time, it can become a powerful source of individuality.

In your chart, Lilith is notably active. The aspects with Neptune and Chiron are particularly close. As a result, Lilith plays a clear role in your personality and in the way you develop your own truth and individuality.

### Lilith sextile Mercury:

This is a strong aspect. Mercury represents thinking, learning, and communication. Lilith gives these qualities an independent and critical character.

You tend to question things that others take for granted. Subjects that are hidden, sensitive, or controversial may actually stimulate your curiosity. Your mind does not merely want to know what something is, but also why it is viewed that way. This aspect therefore strengthens your ability to think independently and put your own ideas into words.

### Lilith sextile Neptune:

This is an exceptionally strong and very close aspect. Neptune represents intuition, imagination, symbolism, and the intangible. Lilith represents the hidden and the part of yourself that refuses to be suppressed.

The combination can create a strong sensitivity to what lies beyond visible reality. You may feel drawn to mysteries, symbolism, intuitive insights, and subjects for which there is not always an immediate rational explanation. This aspect connects your independent nature with your intuitive and imaginative abilities.

### Lilith trine Pluto:

This is a strong and supportive aspect. Pluto represents depth, transformation, and uncovering what is hidden. Lilith likewise has a strong connection with things that are suppressed or kept hidden.

This creates a natural urge to look beneath the surface. You can investigate subjects deeply and are not easily satisfied with a superficial explanation. This aspect also gives Lilith considerable strength. Once you have become convinced of something, it can be difficult to simply persuade you to abandon that conviction.

### Lilith trine Venus:

This is a clear but somewhat softer aspect. Venus represents values, relationships, beauty, and harmony. Lilith represents the unconventional and independent side of yourself.

The trine allows these two sides to work together relatively naturally. You do not have to place your need for freedom completely in opposition to connection. Instead, you may value relationships in which there is room for individuality and authenticity. Your tastes and personal values may also have an unconventional or independent character.

### Lilith square Chiron:

This is a very strong and close aspect. Chiron represents vulnerability and the experiences from which insight can ultimately emerge. Lilith, however, refuses to deny who you are.

This creates tension between the desire to be completely yourself and the sensitivity or fear that can arise when this conflicts with other people.

When you feel that you have to adapt yourself in order to be accepted, this can therefore affect you particularly strongly. At the same time, this aspect offers an important opportunity for development: learning that your individuality and vulnerability are allowed to exist side by side.

## Synthesis: Lilith

Lilith is clearly more than just a background theme in your chart. Her combination with Mercury, Neptune, and Pluto creates a strong connection with thinking, intuition, and depth. As a result, you have a natural tendency to look beyond existing explanations and to investigate precisely what is hidden, unclear, or not immediately obvious.

The very close Lilith–Neptune aspect creates sensitivity to the intangible, while Lilith–Pluto strengthens the need to get to the core of things. Lilith–Mercury ensures that you can also process these insights through thinking and communication.

At the same time, the Lilith–Chiron square shows that expressing yourself completely may not always be easy. This is precisely where an important area of development lies: not suppressing your individuality, but learning to connect it with your vulnerability.

The core of your Lilith is therefore: thinking freely, investigating what is hidden, and not losing yourself in the expectations of others.

## Uranus: The Planet of Lightning

Uranus is regarded as the planet of freedom, innovation, sudden insights, and breakthroughs. Where Saturn represents structure, boundaries, and existing systems, Uranus represents the moment when someone dares to break through those boundaries.

Uranus works like a lightning strike. It brings unexpected insights, new ideas, and changes that can often arise suddenly. Uranus does not ask you to simply accept existing answers, but to investigate for yourself whether another possibility might exist.

The strength of Uranus lies in the ability to look at things differently. It is the energy of the inventor, the reformer, and the person who sees possibilities where others still see limitations.

## Uranus in Sagittarius in the 7th House

Uranus is located in Sagittarius in the 7th house in your chart. This means that the innovative power of Uranus is primarily directed toward knowledge, beliefs, truth, and relationships.

Sagittarius searches for greater connections, philosophy, and meaning. Uranus ensures that this search does not follow a traditional path. There is a need to find answers for yourself and to re-examine existing beliefs.

Because Uranus is in the 7th house, other people play an important role in this process. Encounters and relationships can bring unexpected insights and change your worldview. You may be attracted to people who think differently, are innovative, or challenge you to

look further. The strength of this placement lies in the ability to discover new perspectives through connections with others without losing your own freedom.

Sun conjunct Uranus:

This is an exceptionally strong aspect. It is one of the most powerful aspects in your entire chart. The extremely small orb of only 0°28' means that the energy of Uranus is almost directly connected to your identity. The Sun represents who you are, your life force, and your personal power. Uranus adds freedom, originality, and innovation to this.

This combination creates a strong need to be completely yourself. You do not simply want to live according to existing expectations, but want to discover your own direction. There may be a natural drive to think differently, explore new possibilities, and break through existing patterns. Because Uranus is so closely connected to the Sun, innovation is not merely a separate part of your personality; it is part of who you are.

The strength of this aspect lies in: originality, independent thinking, and sudden insights.

### **Mars sextile Uranus:**

This is a very strong aspect. Mars represents action, willpower, and initiative. Uranus represents change, innovation, and freedom.

With an orb of only 1°06', a powerful connection arises between thinking and doing. New ideas do not simply remain in your mind; there is a natural impulse to try them out.

This aspect provides an experimental drive. You can develop new methods, respond quickly to change, and be willing to approach things differently from others. The strength of this combination lies in: turning innovative ideas into concrete action. It makes Uranus not only a thinker, but also an executor.

### **Ascendant opposition Uranus:**

This aspect is clearly present. The Ascendant shows how you present yourself and how you respond spontaneously to the world. Uranus opposite the Ascendant strongly emphasizes the theme of freedom in your identity and relationships.

Others may experience you as independent, original, or difficult to fit into a fixed pattern. There is a strong need to remain yourself and not be reduced to a particular image. This aspect can create tension when your environment tries to impose rules or expectations that do not suit you.

Its strength lies in: daring to distinguish yourself from the crowd. It helps you avoid automatically following what is considered normal and instead search for your own path.

### Descendant conjunct Uranus:

This aspect is clearly present. The Descendant represents relationships, cooperation, and the way you encounter other people. Uranus here ensures that relationships can often have a transformative or unexpected influence.

You may attract people who think differently, are independent, or bring new ideas. Relationships can become important moments of change. At the same time, this placement requires space within connection. A relationship should provide freedom and encourage personal growth.

Its strength lies in: growing through encounters that change your worldview.

### Synthesis: Uranus (Lightning)

Uranus is one of the most dominant planets in your chart. In particular, the Sun–Uranus conjunction at 0°28' makes Uranus a core component of your personality. The Mars–Uranus sextile at 1°06' then provides the ability to turn innovative insights into actual action.

In your chart, Uranus energy is primarily directed toward truth, knowledge, freedom, and breaking through existing ideas. You are not merely focused on receiving knowledge, but on investigating, renewing, and discovering new possibilities for yourself.

The central power of Uranus in your chart is: The flash of lightning that breaks through fixed patterns and makes new insights visible. The archetype that corresponds to this is: The Innovator, the one who examines existing boundaries and opens new paths.

### Synthesis: Western Birth Chart

This birth chart shows a personality in which research, insight, and innovation are central themes. The different components of the chart reinforce one another and together create the image of someone who does not merely want to collect knowledge, but above all wants to understand what lies hidden behind visible reality.

The foundation is formed by the combination of the Sun, Moon, and Ascendant. The Sun in Sagittarius in the 7th house creates a strong need for growth, truth, and meaning. There is a natural drive to explore the world and gain new insights. Because of its placement in the 7th house, relationships and encounters play an important role in this development. Other people can act as mirrors that open new perspectives and contribute to personal growth.

The Moon in Scorpio in the 6th house gives emotional depth and a strong need to get to the core of situations. Feelings are experienced intensely, and superficial answers provide little satisfaction. The Scorpio nature searches for hidden causes and patterns. In the 6th house, this energy becomes connected with development, improvement, and the refinement of skills.

The Ascendant in Gemini adds curiosity, communication, and the ability to make connections. This creates a combination in which the mind is constantly gathering information, the Sun searches for meaning, and the Moon investigates what lies beneath the surface.

One of the greatest strengths in this chart is the Sagittarius stellium consisting of the Sun, Mercury, Jupiter, Uranus, and Neptune. This strong concentration emphasizes the search for knowledge, truth, and greater connections. Jupiter strengthens the need for growth and understanding, while Mercury provides a broad and investigative way of thinking. The very strong Sun conjunct Uranus (0°28') adds another dimension: the need to think independently and re-examine existing ideas is an important part of the identity. Mercury conjunct Neptune (0°52') connects thinking with intuition, creating an ability to sense symbolism, patterns, and hidden connections.

In addition to the Sagittarius stellium, the Scorpio stellium consisting of the Moon, Saturn, and Pluto forms a second dominant force. Where Sagittarius searches for the truth, Scorpio wants to understand that truth completely. The Moon conjunct Saturn gives emotional strength, discipline, and the ability to seriously investigate difficult processes. Pluto strengthens the transformative effect and creates a natural aptitude for bringing hidden layers to light.

The key aspects form the engine of this birth chart. The connection between the Sun and Uranus provides originality and a capacity for innovation. Mars sextile Uranus (1°06') ensures that new ideas do not merely arise, but can also be turned into action. Venus conjunct Pluto gives intensity in relationships and values, while the connections with Lilith and Chiron show that personal development arises through exploring individuality, vulnerability, and hidden themes.

The emphasis on the 6th, 7th, and 8th houses reveals a clear developmental progression. The 6th house calls for growth and improvement, the 7th house teaches through encounters with others, and the 8th house seeks deeper knowledge and transformation. The chart therefore moves from experience to insight and ultimately to meaning.

The MC in Capricorn indicates the social direction: building something of value based on responsibility and development. The connections with Pluto and Chiron show that personal experiences and profound insights can ultimately play an important role in what is brought into the world.

The North Node in Gemini in the 1st house emphasizes the development of an individual voice. The challenge is not only to search for great truths, but also to keep listening, asking questions, and exploring different perspectives.

The deeper layers of the chart become visible through Lilith and Chiron. Lilith strengthens the theme of independent thinking and exploring subjects beyond existing

frameworks. Chiron in Taurus in the 12th house points toward a development in which inner security and self-worth become increasingly important.

When all the components are considered together, the image emerges of someone driven by a strong need to understand, investigate, and innovate. The greatest strength lies in connecting knowledge, intuition, and depth. The greatest challenge lies in finding a balance between the continuous search for new insights and the creation of peace and stability.

The core of this birth chart is: A person who searches for hidden connections and new insights through research, depth, and independent thinking, ultimately transforming knowledge into meaning.

Archetype: The Truth Seeker

An independent researcher who is not easily satisfied with existing explanations. The driving force lies in understanding what is hidden, contradictory, or misunderstood. Confrontation with others and with existing beliefs is not an obstacle, but rather a way of moving closer to a personal truth.

# Chinese astrology



## Chinese astrology

Within Chinese astrology, my profile strongly indicates a life characterized by constant mental tension. As I described in the chapter where I discuss my bipolar disorder, there are people who become overwhelmed when they can feel my energy during a manic episode. I drive them to the point of madness. This energy is described as a relentless flow, symbolized by the element of Water, which rarely finds a way to discharge. The profile indicates that this specific configuration represents the element of lightning, pointing to a powerful and sudden release of accumulated forces.

### Year of Birth: 1983

The Year Pillar feels like a deep, silent ocean from which you originate. This is the layer associated with your origins, your early imprint, and how the outside world initially perceives you. Yin Water on the Pig creates the image of someone who is naturally sensitive to undercurrents, someone who perceives more than what is actually being said. There is an inherent softness here, but also enormous depth. This is not superficial emotion, but rather a quiet intensity. People may experience you as calm or reserved, while beneath the surface something is constantly moving. This is the energy of someone who senses things before they become visible.

### Month of Birth: December

The Month Pillar repeats exactly the same energy, but now it shifts from the background into your everyday experience. This makes it not a coincidental trait, but a dominant force within your personality. Where others may reflect from time to time, you live in that state continuously. You are constantly processing, analyzing, and feeling. This can manifest as a strong inner world in which you make connections, but also as a tendency to remain absorbed within yourself. Because this pillar is associated with your childhood and environment, it suggests that you may have grown up in an atmosphere in which sensitivity, consciously or unconsciously, played a major role. The doubling of Water means that your inner world is not a secondary feature, but the core of how you experience reality.

### Day of Birth: 2

The Day Pillar is where you become visible as an individual. This is your core, your “self.” Yang Wood is like a great tree that wants to grow, seeks direction, and wants to give meaning to what it absorbs. In your case, this tree stands in a landscape already saturated with Water. This means that you are nourished by everything you feel and perceive, but it can also mean that you sometimes struggle to maintain a clear direction. The Tiger beneath this Wood gives you an inner drive toward movement and development. There is fire at the foundation of this pillar: an impulse to do something with everything you absorb. This is the part of you that wants to grow, create, and move

forward, but that can sometimes be held back by the abundance of impressions and thoughts.

### Birth Time: 16:00

The Hour Pillar reveals what takes place within your deepest inner layers and how you move toward the future. Here, Metal enters the configuration, changing the dynamic. Metal is sharp, analytical, and cutting. Where Water dissolves and spreads everything, Metal tries to separate and define. This means that there is a force within you that wants to create order out of the chaos of your thoughts and feelings. But because Metal can cut Wood, tension also arises here. It can feel as though one part of you is constantly correcting, judging, or pressuring yourself to become clearer, sharper, or stronger. This is the source of your analytical ability, but also of inner criticism and mental tension.

### Synthesis: Chinese Astrology

When these four pillars are brought together, the image emerges of someone living in a world of depth and movement while simultaneously searching for form and direction. ## Numerology Calculation Tables

What makes numerology so difficult is that the calculation system differs depending on the country. Every language has its own calculation model. I have taken the effort to develop a number of models for different languages. For example, the Spanish language has 27 letters, and the placement of the Ñ means that the same symbols we use have a different meaning. In terms of their numerical meaning, they shift one position.

Numerology indicates that symbols do not possess an inherent value; rather, it is the meaning that we ourselves assign to them. The Dutch model is also used for German, French, and the English language.

### Special Feature: Greek Model

Just like in Dutch, a Greek name begins with a capital letter and ends in lowercase letters. To calculate a Greek name, you must first use the uppercase-letter model to determine the value of the first letter. The rest of the name is calculated using the lowercase-letter model.

This is important because uppercase letters in Greek can have a different symbol from their lowercase counterparts. In the case of Sigma, see position 9 in the lowercase-letter model, which contains two symbols. The  $\sigma$  is used in the middle of a word, while  $\varsigma$  is used only at the end of a word.

The strength lies in renewing existing situations without losing sight of the need for a solid foundation.

### Venus in Cancer: Sextile (5.3%)

Venus represents love, connection, appreciation, and what a person considers important. In Cancer, these qualities take on a strongly emotional and protective meaning. The sextile indicates an opportunity to use these qualities naturally. There is room for warmth, involvement, and maintaining valuable relationships. This influence supports a caring way of dealing with people and things that are important.

### Saturn in Cancer: Sextile (5.3%)

Saturn represents responsibility, boundaries, discipline, and structure. In Cancer, this energy is primarily focused on protection, connection, and emotional security. The sextile shows that responsibility and involvement can support each other. This allows a person to take responsibility for people and matters that are important in a calm and practical way. The strength lies in providing stability without losing emotion and connection.

### Sun in Leo: Conjunction (25.2%)

The Sun represents identity, individuality, life force, and the way a person presents themselves. Leo strengthens confidence, creativity, and presence. The conjunction makes these qualities especially strong. This creates a powerful need to express oneself and follow one's own direction. This influence gives considerable personal presence and the desire to play a visible role.

### Mercury in Leo: Conjunction (25.2%)

Mercury represents thinking, learning, communication, and processing information. In Leo, thoughts and words take on a clear, confident, and creative expression. The conjunction strengthens these qualities and makes communication an important part of personal expression. Ideas can therefore be expressed with conviction and clarity. This supports the ability to bring others into one's own story or vision.

### Mars in Virgo: Conjunction (27.6%)

Mars represents determination, initiative, energy, and the way a person takes action. Virgo directs this energy toward precision, practical matters, and improving situations. The conjunction strengthens the combination of determination and purpose. This allows energy to be used very practically to carry out plans and achieve results. The strength lies in carefully and purposefully turning plans into action.

### Neptune in Virgo: Conjunction (27.6%)

Neptune represents imagination, intuition, ideals, and the ability to look beyond what is visible. In Virgo, this sensitivity is combined with a practical and precise way of observing things. The conjunction makes these qualities strongly present. This allows ideals and ideas to be connected with a desire to apply them practically. ### Jupiter in Scorpio: Trine (10%)

Jupiter represents growth, knowledge, conviction, and the search for a greater understanding of life. In Scorpio, this search takes on a deep and investigative character. The trine creates a natural cooperation between growth and depth. This allows knowledge to be built through research, experience, and understanding complex subjects. This influence supports a strong need to look beyond what is immediately visible.

### North Node in Sagittarius: Conjunction (47.6%)

The North Node represents the direction in which a person develops throughout life according to this method. Sagittarius represents knowledge, freedom, discovery, and the search for truth. The strong conjunction makes these qualities particularly prominent. It creates a strong drive to conduct one's own research and develop an

independent conviction. This life direction therefore places strong emphasis on discovering, learning, and searching for a greater whole.

### **Lilith in Sagittarius: Conjunction (47.6%)**

The trine allows feelings and responsibility to support each other more easily. This enables emotions to be used to act in a purposeful and responsible manner. The strength lies in connecting inner feelings with practical goals and responsibilities.

### **Pluto in Capricorn: Trine (11.7%)**

Pluto represents profound change, power, control, and letting go of what no longer works. In Capricorn, this energy has a strong connection with responsibility, structure, and determination. The trine allows change and structure to strengthen each other. This enables inner strength to be used to create lasting changes and concrete results. The strength lies in handling difficult situations in a controlled manner and implementing changes purposefully.

### **Chiron in Pisces: Sextile (5.3%)**

Chiron represents vulnerability, personal experiences, and the ability to gain wisdom from those experiences. In Pisces, this is connected with sensitivity, intuition, compassion, and empathy. The sextile indicates an opportunity to use these qualities in a supportive way. Personal experiences can be transformed into greater understanding of others. The strength lies in using sensitivity and experience as sources of insight and compassion.

## Appendix: Birth Chart

## The Basics of Astrology in Brief

When it comes to Western astrology, I will keep the basics short and to the point. If you want to calculate and determine your destiny, you need to have your birth data, accurate down to the exact hour and minute. Without this information, things become very difficult, and even a fifteen-minute difference in birth time can produce different and incorrect placements. The main problem lies with the Ascendant, the point where the first house begins.

There are thirteen constellations in total and astrology contains six elements. When it comes to the birth chart, the Serpent Bearer plays no role. The twelve zodiac signs do not shift and remain exactly where they have always been.

There are four basic elements: fire, earth, air, and water. If we include the Serpent Bearer, two additional elements are added: thunder and lightning. The Serpent Bearer does not play a visible role in astrology, but in numerology this is completely different. In numerology, the Serpent Bearer is always a fixed part of the whole.

I have developed an approach that allows you to create a birth chart yourself in just ten minutes. However, I do recommend following the correct order. When you begin with astrology, it is more important to first focus properly on your Sun, Moon, and Ascendant rather than immediately diving into the deeper layers. For a healthy and stable life, it is important to master this trinity and allow all three parts to reach their full potential. Take control.

If you do not have the birth data, you can still determine a great deal of information, such as many planetary placements. However, some important and determining points, such as the houses and the Ascendant, will remain unknown.

## Approach: Birth Chart

I have decided to focus this book entirely on the construction of a birth chart. In the past, having a birth chart created often cost around €60, but thanks to AI, almost anyone can now create an extensive birth chart themselves within ten minutes.

I have personally ordered many birth charts, but none of them included a synthesis. In addition, the techniques used in many of these charts differ enormously, and the language is often unnecessarily vague. For example, one chart stated that my Jupiter was unaspected, but it later turned out that this was not the case at all. The quality of some birth charts varies enormously. The advantage of AI is that it can combine information from many different sources and perspectives, making it possible to create a more extensive and consistent overview.

I am someone who places great value on efficiency and working toward a clear goal. Since childhood, this has been my motto in life: achieve as much as possible with as little effort as possible.

What I have done is develop a clear instruction for AI. After that, it is mainly a matter of copying and pasting the questions. Before you begin, first copy the instruction into the AI. My advice is to copy each step in full, including all of the accompanying questions, and provide them to the AI all at once. In total, you therefore only need to copy and paste nine times to have all the questions answered.

I recommend following these steps and allowing the complete document to be created before you begin reading and studying it. Of course, you can choose to carefully examine each step first, but keep in mind that you can easily spend hours doing so.

When presenting a birth chart, I recommend always starting with the synthesis. This forms the introduction and immediately provides a clear overview of the most important themes and the central thread running through the chart.

After you have copied and pasted all the steps, therefore place step 9 (the synthesis) at the very beginning of the document. The reader will then first receive a clear summary of the personality and can subsequently explore, step by step, the individual components that support this conclusion. The remaining steps can then follow in their original order. These provide a deeper explanation and foundation for the synthesis.

Once the document is complete, adjust the formatting according to your own preferences. This will make the birth chart much more pleasant to read in the future. If you want more depth, you can always ask the AI for further clarification, and you can of course add your own questions to the list. My questionnaire is merely intended as a foundation.
